

#### Drop the drive for perfection

Journalist and novelist Anna Quindlen says that when she was younger and in college that she rose every day and tried to be perfect—in every possible way. She studied when she was supposed to, she got her assignments turned in on time and she smiled at everyone as she passed them in the dorm halls.

In a 1999 commencement address given at Barnard, where she had graduated 25 years earlier, she said that being perfect was hard work—and the rules changed. What constituted perfection in 1970 when she started college (sweaters and pleated skirts) morphed into her new version (Doc Martens and turtlenecks) as she found herself striving to be a hyper intellectual.

Eventually, the burden of trying to be perfect year after year became too heavy. Here are her words of wisdom on the art of perfectionism:

"Trying to be perfect may be sort of inevitable for people like us, who are smart and ambitious and interested in the world and in its good opinion. But at one level it's too hard, and at another, it's too cheap and easy. Because it really requires you mainly to read the zeitgeist of wherever and whenever you happen to be, and to assume the masks necessary to be the best of whatever zeitgeist dictates or requires. Those requirements shapeshift, sure, but when you're clever you can read them and do the imitation required.

"But nothing important, or meaningful, or beautiful, or interesting, or great ever came out of imitations. The thing that is really hard, and really amazing, is giving up on being perfect and beginning the work of becoming yourself."

#### Daily meditation can bring insight

When you're feeling at loose ends, it could be a good idea to participate in some type of meditation. According to the Web site *Learningtomeditate.com*, you don't have to think of meditation as

an Eastern art, complicated to learn, where an old man under a tree comes up with all the answers to the mysteries of life. It can be a lot more practical than that. Meditation often is no more than seeking out peacefulness and calmness during the stress and struggle of everyday living. Simple practices can work well. Find a quiet place, focus on

your breathing and grow quiet. Eventually you will grow calm, and if you practice on a daily basis and learn how to empty your mind, you may find that you gain insight into matters that seemed to evade your understanding previously.

A: Six. One to turn the bulb, one for support, and four to relate to the experience.


Q: How many psychiatrists does it take to change a light bulb? A: Only one, but the bulb has got to really WANT to change.



#### Do you know a horse's favorite flavors?

A coording to a study published in Applied Animal Behavior Science and the Discovery Web site, when it comes to flavors horses prefer fenugreek, banana and cherry flavored feed. While most commercial horse feeds come in molasses, garlic and mint flavors, horses in the study turned up their noses to garlic flavored feeds unless there was nothing else available to munch on.

Horses in the study ranked their favorite flavors in the following order: fenugreek, banana, cherry, rosemary, cumin, carrot, peppermint and oregano. And even though horses are often fed apples, in the study horses seemed to prefer bananas.

The horses rejected feeds laced with echinacea, coriander and nutmeg. Previous studies found that horses like to smell coriander, but that apparently does not translate into also liking to eat it, the study found. This is much like how some people love the smell of coffee, but they do not like to drink it.

#### Affirmations can have powerful effect

hen you are struggling with issues in your mind, it is often helpful to practice affirmations. This can be done in different ways, either internally and silently or externally out loud or through the written word.

Practicing affirmations on a daily basis can have a powerful effect in moving your life in the direction you would like to go. For instance, to practice written affirmations, find a quiet comfortable place where you can have some privacy. Take along a pen and pad of paper. Spend a few minutes thinking about some things that you wish you had or wish were true in your life. Make a list of a few things that you want to work on or toward in your life. And then every morning first thing, write these things down like they are already true. For example, if you want a new computer, but you don't have a way of getting one right now, write: "I own the computer of my dreams." If you want to develop confidence as a presenter, write, "I am a confident presenter."

When these thoughts are focused on, it can often set your mind in motion and you might find yourself taking actions or finding ways to make your desires become realities.


