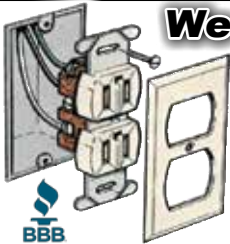

GENTLE REMINDERS

When driving through the Park after sunset, please be sure to turn your headlights on. We have a lot of walkers out there after dark and want to be sure they can do so safely.



Remember that the speed limit is **15 mph** in the Park. It may seem slow, but it was set for everyone's safety. Report vendors that you notice repeatedly driving too fast to their respective companies. If it is a park resident, please notify the office and they will address the issue.

Please do your part to help keep the park clean by not tossing cigarette butts on the ground. It may *seem* insignificant, but besides being unsightly, did you know that cigarette filters can take as long as 10 years to decompose while releasing toxins into the environment? Let's keep the park beautiful!

If you are having an event or participating in an activity in the Rec Hall or the Card Room, please clean up when you are through. All trash and recycling should be taken to their proper place and the room tidied. In other words – leave the room as you found it.

Also, please **check your mail** on a regular basis as the mailboxes fill up fast. If mail is not picked up for awhile, we will assume you are not here, and the mail will be sent back.

RECYCLING

Help the Park recycle! There are many reasons why recycling is essential. Not only can it help reduce your carbon footprint, but it also helps reduce the need for harvesting raw materials, saves energy, reduces greenhouse gases, prevents pollution, and more. By improving our recycling habits, we can help keep the environment clean and preserve our natural resources. So that we can all do our part, you can find a recycling bin at the intersection of Row 1 and Row 6 right here in the Park. Let's fill it up!



But please be mindful of what and where you are putting your recycling items. It only takes a minute to break down a box and put bottles and cans in the proper place. *All items must be clean and dry.*

BIG BLUE DUMPSTER-

You may put the following into this dumpster:

- Cardboard – Broken down
- Mixed Paper (Newspaper, Junk Mail, etc.)
- Recyclable plastic containers # 1 – 7 or anything with the recycling symbol on it
- Aluminum, Tin, or Steel Cans
- Glass Bottles and Jars
- Paper, Milk, or Juice Cartons

You cannot put Styrofoam or Plastic Bags in this dumpster.

If you take your recyclables to the dumpster in a plastic bag, ***please*** remove them from the bag and put the bag into the regular green trash dumpster. Plastic bags jam up the sorting machines at the recycling center.

"But Dad," protests the boy, "when George Washington admitted it was he who cut the tree, his father didn't punish him!"

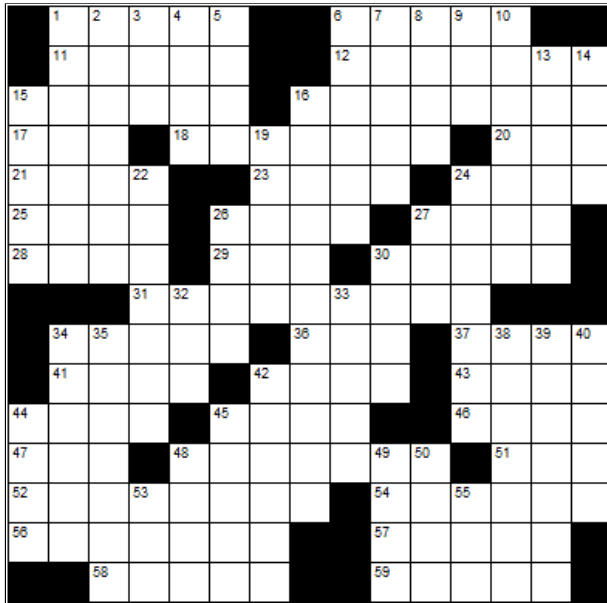
