ear Fellow Residents:

County Sewer Project: Duncan Brown, Ron Markham, and Steve Schaefer met with the Pinellas County engineer and project manager in charge of the Sewer Replacement Project. Concerns regarding the easement and other issues were discussed. LSR sent a letter to the County requesting changes to the agreement especially for the easement wording. The County supplied LSR with the 100% design documents and the design specifications. These documents are very detailed and include the requirements to repave the streets where sewers are installed and bring the park back to the condition prior to the construction. The board is waiting for updates to the agreement.

Hurricane Season: Hurricane season is almost here. Please be prepared for the worst. A separate email will be sent out regarding where to look for hurricane preparedness.

Disaster Preparedness: Please make sure the office has your latest emergency contact information on file.

Water Leak Testing: Volunteers conducted water leak checks on most of the homes in the park. Most of the homes tested were leak free. Where leaks were found, the homeowners were notified. During the testing, a major leak was found in the spa. This leak was repaired, and the spa is back on-line. The daily water usage is now on a par with the usage last year.

LSR Tools: Tools and supplies continue to be missing from the maintenance shed. The tools, batteries, and plumbing supplies are not for the general use of the residents but are for park use.

Land Depression: A land depression area was discovered in the park under a mobile home. The land is owned by the park and is the responsibility of the park. The area where this depression was found has been an ongoing issue. A contract was issued to repair this problem. A Special Board Meeting was held to approve the funds required for this repair on 18 March 2024. A second land depression was discovered in March. This depression is not large and will be repaired as soon as possible.

Maintenance:

- The new air conditioner has not yet been installed in the hall. A contractor has finally been identified and the work will be scheduled in April.
- LSR has started mowing the grass. This has not been without some start-up problems. The board is focusing on the grass cutting with Ron Markham and Tom Henry working to set a schedule and process for cutting the lawns.
- Duke Energy has denied the claim submitted for the underground wiring fault going to the hall.







- 1. Emergency Shelters A list of shelters and if open, closed, or full and if a general shelter, pet friendly, or special needs
- 2. Special Needs How to register for "Special Needs Assistance" and a list of special needs shelters.
- 3. Sand Bags Info on obtaining sand bags for residents not required to evacuate
- 4. Emergency Road Closures Road closures within Pinellas County
- 5. Know Your Zone Evacuation zones all mobile home parks are under mandatory evacuation during any evacuation order.
- 6. During and After a Storm Information on cleanup after the storm.
- 7. Disaster Assistance Information on insurance claims and FEMA

It is very important that any resident requiring assistance for evacuation, register on the "Special Needs" site. It is the only way that the County will be aware of their needs whether it is medical, mobility, or transportation, etc.

Our in-house LSR "Disaster Relief" form is to supply basic info to assist EMS and First Responders to perform search and rescue within the park during a severe weather event.
