Jeanne B. Frymire January 6, 1914 – April 22, 2015

Tribute to Jeanne B. Frymire

Jeanne is one of those people you will want to meet when you get to heaven. Although personally, I hardly knew her, I have learned wonderful tales from the people that did. She was admired and revered by residents of Amber Glades. This history of her is adapted from an autobiographic accounting of her life that she wrote just before her 100th birthday.

Her story started back on January 6, 1914 in Atlantic City, New Jersey. In Jeanne's words, "I was christened "Regina" a name I have always despised. I was always known as Jeanne, spelled in various ways. A letter of introduction to my first job spelled my name "Jeanne" and I have spelled it that way ever since."

Jeanne attended kindergarten for two months in Atlantic City. Upon moving to Margate, NJ she was placed in the third grade because she could already read at the age of 5. She graduated in 1930 as Salutatorian of her class and received a medal for General Excellence.

Going to college part-time, Jeanne graduated with high honors with an Associate Degree in Business Administration.

Jeanne worked in this field until her retirement at age 70. She earned her BA in Language and Literature in 1975. She worked at Atlantic Community College where she advanced to the position of Administrative Assistant to the President [and we all know what that means....she basically ran the place].

Jeanne and William Henry Frymire were married on April 4, 1942 and were life partners. They had no children. William died on October 26, 1996 after fifty-four years of marriage. They celebrated, at Amber Glades clubhouse, their fiftieth wedding anniversary and traveled to Europe later that year.

Upon on Jeanne's retirement in 1983, she and her husband immediately moved to Safety Harbor, FL, thus Amber Glades. Many of you know and tell of the countless hours when Jeanne volunteered her time to the betterment of Amber Glades. She worked on many committees, events, and activities and was a member of the Social Committee for over 20 years. She also served as editor of the Amber Glades Newsletter.

Jeanne was humbled that on her 100th birthday her friends would give her a party honoring her and January 6, 2014 would be declared Jeanne B. Frymire Day. In her words, "I see nothing note-worthy at having achieved this age and see no reason I should be honored. I would prefer to have been honored for having written a great book or having made some scientific discovery. I have no regrets about my life. I have enjoyed everything I have done. I am fortunate to have so many good friends and I highly value our relationships. I think they over-rate me and I wish I could do more for them."

Although Jeanne requested no memorial service after her death, I hope she won't mind that many here at Amber Glades and many in the surrounding area take a moment to reflect on all the times that she gave us friendship, lent a helping hand or volunteered to do something that benefitted us all. Thank you Jeanne, and may you find rest.

***Next Walk-in-Movie will be July 12th. Watch for details as the date gets nearer.


A WONDERFUL MOTHER'S DAY

FLAG DAY - JUNE 14



Eat Better to Spur Creativity

ome great artists and writers are known to have used drugs or alcohol to seek inspiration, but you don't have to risk your health when you need a creative boost. The Medical Daily website suggests trying some of these foods to help stimulate the brain:

• **Fruit**. Fruits have lots of an amino acid called tyrosine, which helps synthesize proteins and may influence your ability to think deeply. In one study, students performed better at completing puzzles when they drank orange juice strong with tyrosine.



- •Chocolate. The flavanols in chocolate may enhance short-term cognitive skills, according to one British study, because flavanols boost the amount of oxygen in the brain. Try a cup of hot cocoa before you need to be at the top of your mental game.
- Carbohydrates. Carbs deliver a quick dose of glucose to your body and brain, providing aid to concentration and memory. Potatoes, oatmeal, and other carbs may have a beneficial effect on brain function
- Walnuts. Rich in omega-3 fatty acids, walnuts can help memory and increase brain function, according to the journal Plant Foods for Human Nutrition. The results of one study showed that rats given a diet of raw walnuts for 28 days showed better learning and memory than rodents on another diet.
