FLAG DAY - JUNE 14th

ag Etiquette and Respect

- The United States flag should never be dipped to anyone or thing.
 - The flag is flown upside-down as a distress signal only.
 - The flag should not touch the ground.
 - A won flag should be retired with dignity thru a flag burning ceremony usually performed by The American Legion or Boy and Girl Scout Troops.
 - When displaying the flag on a flag pole the U.S. flag should be the top flag when displayed with others.
 - When displayed over a street, it should be hung vertically with the union (stars) closest to the north or east.
 - When displayed over a sidewalk the union should be furthest away from the building.
 - The flag is saluted throughout the time it is raised or lowered, or until the last note of the National Anthem.
 - The flag should be illuminated if displayed at night.
 - Indoors the flag is placed to the right of the speaker.
 - When displayed on a wall the union should be at the top and to the observers left when hung either horizontally or vertical.
 - On Memorial Day the flag is to be displayed at half-staff until noon and at full-staff after noon.
 - Before raising a flag to half-staff it should always be raised to full-staff and then lowered to half-staff. It should also be once more raised to full-staff before lowering the flag from half-staff.

A DAD REMEMBERED

irst person you'll want to meet in Heaven is Gene Mandell. My dad. He will seem quiet at first, but I think that is because he is planning his next tease, his next practical joke, his next Bridge game, his next golf game, his next adventure......you'll like him.

One hot day in late June of 1967 we were off on vacation. I was excited because my best friend, Jean, was going along on a two week camping trip to somewhere out west. I remember getting as far as the St. Louis Arch, but not much more than that. The arch opened just the week before and we waited in line 6 hours to go to the top.

But, I digress. We arrived early at Jean's house the morning of our departure. Her mother stood talking to my parents, in the driveway, before we got under way. Us kids were clamoring to get on the road. As we sat in the car waiting, I heard Jean's mother mention the hot weather and how it was going to be to drive with the heat. Innocently, my dad says, "It shouldn't be bad with air conditioning." Since air conditioning was not even thought of as a standard feature on cars yet, especially the old Rambler station wagon we had, Jean's mother fell right into his trap. Surprised, she ask, "You have air conditioning in your car?" Dad's answer, "Doesn't everyone?" Disbelief raised the eyebrows of his unsuspecting victim as he finished his statement. "We just crank down all the windows and we have all the air conditioning we need!"

My aunts were many times the brunt of my dad's antics. We would all spend weekends at Aunt Louise and Uncle John's in Alliance, OH. They had a backyard pool and what fun it was to be able to play and cool off in the pool with all our cousins and friends. Dad organized the diving championships. After an afternoon of enjoying a bit of beer from the basement tap, my dad and uncles proceeded to entertain us by diving thru little inner-tubes and acting pretty silly. My dad never drank at home so this was a whole new side of dad we kids had never seen...and rarely did again.

But, I digress. On one such weekend, dad brought gifts for all my aunts. He presented his gifts to them poolside. Wrapped in taped up shoe boxes, with a note on the top of each box that read. TO BE WORN WHILE SWIMMING. Inside they found dangle earrings with heavy rocks attached to them.

Another time, we were having Thanksgiving dinner at Aunt Louise and Uncle John's. Aunt Louise had a huge turkey cooking in the oven when we arrived. What she didn't know was that my dad had brought along a surprise for her. Her turkey was roasting in an old navy blue roaster with white poke-a-dots on it (you remember, everyone had one). Well, earlier that morning, dad had mom roast up a Cornish hen in a mini roasting pan of the identical same colors. While Aunt Louise was out of the kitchen he switched pans in the oven. You can guess the rest when Aunt Louise next opened the oven to check on Thanksgiving dinner.

Dad was always helping someone. He bailed us out many times fixing a leaky drain, putting up drywall, painting a wall. He retired at the age of 55. I can remember as a child hearing him say he was going to retire at 55. That was his goal, and he did it. 37 years he worked for The Toledo Edison. Starting at the age of 18 as a lineman, climbing thousands of poles. 2 weeks

days, 2 weeks afternoons, 2 weeks nights. Later he worked as a crew supervisor. He and mom moved to Sun City, AZ when they retired. They returned to Ohio 2-3 times a year. Staying with us when they did.

But, I digress. We would fly out to visit them each year in AZ. Our youngest son learned how to walk on their gravel yard. After being there several days, the first time we visited after their move, I noticed dad would get 1, maybe 2 calls each day on the phone, leave for a few minutes and then come back. Finally, I ask mom what he did on these short jaunts. She said he was the youngest man around the neighborhood and he was just going to help someone move their TV, furniture, etc. Just helping out.

Dad died at the age of 65. I remember thinking I was so glad he got to retire at 55 and have 10 years of traveling and golf. I remember the morning mom called to say he had died in his sleep, after a day of golf and dinner with friends. Monday after Thanksgiving. I shouldn't have been so shocked. You see, he tried to warn me. Actually, he tried to warn me and my siblings. Give us a heads up. But, we just weren't listening. Two weeks before he died, my 3 siblings and I got similar phone calls all starting with, "I can die anytime now. I just did what I have always wanted to do." He had went skydiving that morning.

When you get to heaven look up Gene Mandell and give him a hug from me.

A few days later he received a letter from his son: "Dear Dad, Don't dig up that garden! That's where I buried the THINGS!" Love, Jake


At 4am the next morning, FBI agents and local police arrived and dug up the entire area looking for the THINGS. They apologized to the old man after not finding anything and left.

Keeping a case or two of bottled water is also suggested. After the storm has passed, and you return, there may not be utility services right away.






