<u>Hurricane Season</u> – Hurricane Season continues through the end of November. Be sure you are prepared in advance for a storm by picking up a 2019 hurricane guide in the business office.

<u>Town Hall Meeting</u> – This month's Town Hall Meeting with the Board of Directors is scheduled for Wednesday, October 9th in the Clubhouse. Come share your ideas and learn what your board and management team are working on.

<u>Landscaping</u> — Over the summer, we have planted approximately 40 new palm trees throughout the park. The large island bed in front of the clubhouse is being redesigned, with new landscaping scheduled to be installed in October. Thanks to the Landscaping Committee for all their hard work on this project.

<u>Serving on the Board</u> – The Annual Meeting is scheduled for January 15th. At that time, three shareholders will be elected to serve on the Board of Directors. Please consider volunteering to be a candidate for the Board. An official notice with all the details will be mailed out in November.

<u>Dial Directory</u> – If you have changes you would like made to your listing in the Dial Directory, please call or email the office so we can ensure your information is updated. The deadline for the business office to submit changes is December 1, 2019.

<u>Rules Reminder</u> – Section C: Alterations and Modifications 1. All painting and exterior maintenance, upgrades, construction, alterations, improvements and additions must receive written approval of Management. Prior to any work commencing, a drawing must be submitted to the Architectural and Homesite Committee (ARHC) who will then make recommendations for approval. Once approved by the Architectural Committee, it is then sent to the manager for approval and as well as one board member. The management will issue a Community building permit before any necessary permits through city or county will be issued. A copy of all permit(s) will be kept in the Resident's file at the office. All permits will be displayed on job site to be visible from the street. It shall not be the responsibility of the Corporation to ensure that all required building permits are obtained by Residents prior to work commencing.

Helping Hands

Prostate Cancer

ancer of the prostate, a gland in the male reproductive system, is a major health concern for American men. The disease is rare before age 50, and experts believe most elderly men have traces of it. Prostate cancer is the most common cancer found only in men and the third most common non-skin cancer diagnosed in Americans. The American Cancer Society estimates that nearly 175,000 new cases of prostate cancer will be diagnosed in the United States in 2019.

Despite increased screening and a steady decline in the number of prostate cancer deaths over the years, prostate cancer still is the second leading cause of cancer deaths among American men. About 30,000 men die from the disease each year. The death rate is twice as high for African American men than any other group.

Most cases of prostate cancer - 99 percent - are adenocarcinomas, which develop when gland cells mutate and grow out of control, forming a tumor. Most men with the cancer die of other causes, and many never know they have it. But once prostate cancer begins to grow quickly or spreads, it is dangerous.

Doctors cannot say with certainty what causes prostate cancer, but experts generally agree that diet contributes to the risk. Your age, race, and family history may contribute to your risk of developing prostate cancer. There is no evidence that you can prevent prostate cancer. But a healthy diet may help lower your risk.

It's not necessarily true that prostate cancer surgery will end your sex life, or that only elderly men get prostate cancer. Nor do you necessarily have to start treatment right away. Reasons not to treat may include it's in an early stage and growing slowly, or you're elderly or have other illnesses so the treatment may interfere with other health problems.

A high PSA score does not automatically mean that you have prostate cancer. Also, many men with prostate cancer live long lives and ultimately die of other causes.

A diet that helps you stay at a healthy weight may cut your chances of having prostate cancer. Testing or screening for prostate cancer can help find the disease earlier. Only you and your doctor can decide what is YOUR next step.
