President's Message

his summer has really been different than any other one we have ever been through before.

With Covid-19 still so scary the park seems empty. People are staying home. We are limited on what we can do in the park due to the mandated assembly numbers.

This is really going to be a challenge and a disappointment to so many groups, clubs and gatherings when the snowbirds return. At present we are limited to no more than 50 people at any time to safely be able to distance and so forth. The number for the pool is only 25. Masks are required to be worn in and out of all facilities here in the park. Masks must be worn into the pool area but it is optional if you wear it while swimming. Then again they need to be worn as you leave. Everyone needs to sign in and out of every facility and sanitize your area before you leave. This is so in case someone becomes ill, we can notify anyone they had come in contact with. Also only residents are allowed to use any of our facilities at this time. We feel bad that family and friends can't participate but residents safety is on the top of our priority list. These rules probably won't change until we have a vaccine and it proves effective.

People who went North and into cities and towns that don't have the high number of cases will be shocked when they realize how shut down we have been since they left. A lot of our residents haven't been away from their homes since April. We get our mail and groceries and go back home. We don't coffee klatch, play cards or visit. The pool is semi deserted after lap swimmers and exercise group are finished. Luckily we see people walking, driving golf carts and strolling their dogs so we can keep an eye on our neighbors.

A lot of us have cleaned out closets, cupboards, etc. The White Elephant Sale should be the biggest and best ever IF we are able to have it. That not only takes a lot of workers but a bigger amount of buyers.

Elections this year will be our real challenge. As long as we have no cases of the virus in the park, we are a mandated Poling Place. The Democratic Primary had a low turnout and the Republican Primary should be the same. But the election should be well attended even though the push is for Mail-in

Ballets. I'm old school, I waited 18 years to be able to vote and I have voted in every election for over 50 years. This Covid 19 isn't going to stop me. I'll have my mask, gloves and hand sanitizer with me and I will watch the lines until it is a shorter wait time.

The Board will be monitoring the attendance, the building will be professionally cleaned and we may shut down the clubhouse depending on the numbers of outsiders who will enter our gates.

As President of the Board, my goal is to keep this park and the residents as safe as possible. So stay safe, healthy and in good spirits. Remember we are all in this together.

Manager's Message

• I know that like me, your lives have been turned upside down by the COVID-19 virus. The management team and Board of Directors have had to make difficult decisions about closing and re-opening our facilities and we appreciate the patience and understanding you have shown through this situation. Please know that we all want everything to be open and "business as usual" around here and we are working diligently to resume activities as quickly and safely as possible. We are continuing to monitor the situation and will make adjustments as necessary.

- Over the summer, we have been considering making a change to how we staff the gate house overnight. Specifically, by staffing the gate house with resident employees overnight and moving away from having a security vendor handle that shift. If you are interested in applying to work that shift at the gate, please forward me a copy of your resume for consideration.
- Please remember that golf carts are not permitted on sidewalks. Please keep them on the road.
- Due to the upcoming election season, the Board has approved a 30-day moratorium on the prohibition on signs on home-sites. Beginning on October 3rd, up to two campaign signs/flags will be permitted on each home-site. All campaign signs/flags must be removed within five days of the general election. Any signs or flags posted before October 3rd will still be considered a violation.

Police believed they knew the identity of the one young man and have arrested him, hopefully he will let the police know who the other two are. We should not let our guard down due to the one arrest there are others lurking through our neighborhood.



The bad news is:

When the thieves came over the fence they were heard by a resident on Mt. Curve Ave. That resident apparently came out to confront them but thankfully they didn't run into each other.

When the thieves exited they turned a garbage can behind a house on Mt Saxon over and used that so they could jump over the fence to leave.

Sadly, NONE of those people called the police or notified the office. They explained that they didn't think it made any difference.

That thought IS NOT true.

If the Meljac's, and others, had not installed cameras and lights and notified the police EVERY time this has occurred, the police would not have caught this young man.

If we all had not notified the office, put information on this FB (Face Book) page, made

sure people were following safety measures the police would not have caught this thief.

As a community we stay safe because we decide to be pro-active. This means:

- 1. We take responsibility for our safety and our community.
- 2. We lock all doors to cars, house, shed, don't leave keys in golf carts and lock your bikes.
- 3. We don't leave anything of value outside that is not secured.
- 4. We watch out for our neighbors.
- 5. We install outdoor lights and cameras if we can afford the cost. If you can't afford the cameras, the lights and sirens can be done for less than 50 dollars.
- 6. We notify and report ALL instances of attempted theft or trespassing that we see in our park. And, those notifications go to the office and the police.
- 7. And, this one is so important: We Do NOT attempt to go after these criminals ourselves. If you are a gun owner do not confront them with a loaded gun. The officers who were here were very clear about this one. If you choose to do that KNOW THAT IT IS ILLEGAL and you RISK PROSECUTION.


Que Sera Sera

Book Club Reading List for 2020 - 2021



• **EDUCATED** by Tara Westover (memoir) — Tara Westover grew up preparing for the End of Days in rural Idaho with radical survivalist Mormon parents. She didn't get a birth certificate until she was nine and had no medical records because her father did-n't believe in doctors; She and her six older siblings worked in her father's junk-yard. As she grew older, her father's beliefs became more extreme and one of her brothers grew violent. At 17, she decided to educate herself as a means of escape. Within 10 years she had earned a PhD in intellectual history and political thought from Cambridge but was estranged from her parents and half of her siblings. Now 31 and still living in Cambridge, she has written a powerful memoir, Educated, about the transformative power of education and the price she had to pay for it. Learning along the way that to be educated is to learn much more about the world than what's contained in books.

- TWISTED TWENTY SIX by Janet Evanovich (Stephanie Plum series) Grandma Mazur is a widow... again. This time her marriage lasted a whole 45 minutes. The unlucky groom was one Jimmy Rosolli, local gangster, lothario (senior division), and heart attack waiting to happen... well, the waiting is over. It's a sad day, but if she can't have Jimmy at least Grandma can have all the attention she wants as the dutiful widow. But some kinds of attention are not welcomed, particularly when Jimmy's former "business partners" are convinced that his widow is keeping the keys to their financial success for herself. As someone who has spent an entire career fighting bad guys, a set of missing keys should be no challenge for Stephanie Plum. Problem is, the facts are as twisted as a boardwalk pretzel with mustard.
- THE FAMILY UPSTAIRS by Lisa Jewell Soon after her twenty-fifth birthday, Libby Jones returns home from work to find the letter she's been waiting for her entire life. She rips it open with one driving thought: I am finally going to know who I am. She soon learns not only the identity of her birth parents, but also that she is the sole inheritor of their abandoned mansion on the banks of the Thames in London's fashionable Chelsea neighborhood, worth millions. Everything in Libby's life is about to change. But what she can't possibly know is that others have been waiting for this day as well as she is on a collision course to meet them. 

The second had been given the grace of Dharma (truth) but did not fulfill it with effort, and thus experienced the fate of the first sailor.

The third, (because of limited spiritual progress) was able to keep their head up despite being shipwrecked, but could sadly do no more than temporarily tread water.

The fourth sailor represents one who has reached a pivotal moment (in Buddhist understanding).

Why? Because having made meritorious effort, this sailor could actually "see" and most importantly "recognize" the safety of the further shore.

The fifth was actually able to utilize new found understandings and the blessings of a "sacred vision" and began at once swimming to the promised well being of dry terrain.

The sixth sailor, by reaching the relative safety of shallow water, was able to stand upright on their own, and bask in the "close proximity of release" from the peril itself.





Keep a list of emergency numbers by your phone or in an obvious place for emergency personnel

- 1. 911
- 2. Poison control 1-800-222-1222
- 3. Family member or friend
- 4. Healthcare provider office

Safety Proof your home:

- Make sure hallways and stairs are free of objects and well lit.
- Use railings when going up and down stairs.
- Tape area rugs to the floor so they won't slip underfoot. Prevent Falls:
- If you have a problem walking or with balance, ask your healthcare provider about a special falls risk assessment for your home.
- Ask your healthcare provider if you would benefit from an exercise program to prevent falls.
- If you have fallen before, consider wearing an alarm that will contact emergency personnel if you fall.
- Don't rush to answer the phone. Falls can occur when trying to answer the phone. Keep a cordless or cell phone near you or let your answering machine pick up.
- When walking on smooth floors, wear non-slip footwear.




