

she has volunteered. The Sanctuary cares for birds that are no longer able to live in the wild. Once they are healthy, they are returned to the wild, or if they have babies, the babies are released. Many of these birds come back and live in the trees around the area. The pelicans are definitely not afraid of people. They walk along the paths right beside the people. In the trees are nests, and you can see some of the babies and how they are fed by their parents.

This is such a great place to go visit. You do not have to spend hours there to see everything but can spend as much time as you want watching the birds. The area is shady from all the trees, and you can walk through the area and end up on the beach.

The Suncoast Bird Sanctuary is located at 18328 Gulf Blvd, Indian Shores. There is a large, carved wooden statue of a pelican at the entrance. This is very helpful because the entrance is easy to miss. There is no charge to go into the sanctuary, but they do have donation boxes to help feed the birds. I hope you have a chance to go.






