

NOTES FROM THE BAY RANCH OFFICE

Park upgrades October and November: New signs have been installed at the front and back entrance. Palm trees are being trimmed. Shuffleboard courts are in the process of being resurfaced. Please insert photo of new sign here.

Clean-up of the field between the north and south sections of the park is in progress. Starting January 1, 2019, there will be a \$50 a month fee to have anything parked in there. Licenses must also be kept current.

The area around the garbage bins is being cleaned up.

<u>Park upgrades September and October:</u> Upgrades to the park this summer include a lovely tropical mural in the Clubhouse, painted by Sandy Levin; new air conditioning; cleaning the pool of black algae; and cleaning the horseshoe pits and shuffleboard courts.

The office has launched a new, private Facebook page called, "From the Office of Bay Ranch." Management will use it for important announcements about the daily business of the park. Contact the office to become a member. Note: this page does not replace "Neighbors," which is a social page. Contact Adam Pirhofer or Bob or Gin Lupton to become a member of "Neighbors."

The new management is serious about maintaining a clean and neat park. Managing garbage is a big part of this.

- * Please, put ALL garbage in the dumpsters, even big and heavy items like furniture.
- * DO NOT dump behind, beside or anywhere near the trash bins. Put the garbage in the bins.
 - * Put household trash in the smaller trash bins.
- * Do not bring garbage to the bins on Monday morning. By that time, the bins are overflowing. Wait until Monday afternoon or later, when the bins are empty.
- * Pick up for furniture, tree brush/limbs and other debris will be on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday only. Put out trash after 5:00 p.m, the day before.
- *DO NOT DISPOSE OF TVS OR ELECTRONICS IN THE PARK. DO NOT PUT THEM IN OR BESIDE THE DUMPSTER. We get fined. Call pinellascounty.org/recycle to dispose of them.

*If you need help disposing of something, someone in the park may help you for a fee.

Rent Increase: Most residents already know that \$15 rent increase will go into effect starting January 1, 2019. Those in the non pet section paying \$557 will be paying \$572 starting January

1, 2019. Those on a corner lot or in the pet section will be paying \$580. The increase for everyone is \$15.

News from Summer 2018: It will not be news to most Bay Ranch Residents that Bay Ranch Management has been in transition. Carol Lynch-Alvey was named park manager in September after serving as acting manager for several weeks.

This column will include still-current announcements from the FB page. The following information remains in force:

Rules: The Park has rules that everyone received and reviewed when they bought or rented their coach. <u>Please read and follow them.</u> Failure to follow rules is grounds for eviction, and management has shown that it is willing to evict.

September. No cars may be parked on the street at night. Failure to follow this rule may lead to the offending car being towed, resulting in fines. [Ed. Note: I can verify this. EVEN IF you run out to the street before they hook up your car to tow, you will get

Cars parked on the street during the day should be staggered so emergency vehicles can pass by. Do not park on the grass or sidewalk.

Fires: Test your smoke detectors to make sure they work. Recommended action: purchase a fire extinguisher if you don't have one and know how to work it. If a fire starts, spray it with the fire extinguisher immediately and GET OUT OF THE HOUSE. Fire destroys mobile homes very quickly.

Visitors: Reminder:that rent is based on one or two per household. Each person above the two must pay an additional \$30 a month, including visitors who stay over 30 days. Please be proactive about this and pay the money without first being reminded.

Other announcements:

The purified water dispenser at the clubhouse operates on its own schedule. After someone has filled containers, it may take the dispenser some time to regenerate enough water for more containers. There is a light on the dispenser that tells whether it is ready.

Some have questioned why the application fee is "so high." One reason is to help cover garbage fees, since new owners usually throw away most of the furniture and electronics.

Mr. Larson (the owner) calls the lawn service for lawn care on an as-needed basis. The park pays for lawn mowing, etc., once a month but the need sometimes goes unnoticed. If you notice the lawn needs trimming, please let the office know so they can call Mr. Larson.

Sometimes an automobile will leak oil onto our new, nice looking pavement, creating an eyesore. If you notice a leak by your house, call the office to have it cleaned up. Let's keep these streets looking nice!

Lost and Found Dog/Cat: If you have found a dog or cat, you can post on a site called <u>pawboost.com</u> or call Animal Service on Walsingham. If you call, Animal Services will come out, free of charge, to pick up an animal.

All Residents: Rules commonly broken:

- 1. Parking on grass or sidewalk, overnight on street, and/or every day. The Office must authorize overnight parking at the Clubhouse.
- 2. If you have someone living with you, make sure you have registered in the office.
- 3. Piling garbage in front of garbage bins. When you throw garbage, throw it to the back so when you open the door, it doesn't fall out and there is space.

Check mobile for cleaning, trim, awnings, driveway and/or painting.

Merry Christmas

Today, the Bay Ranch Chorus practiced (not for the first time this season) for the Christmas program. Thanksgiving is 2 weeks away and Christmas less than 6 weeks. The holiday season is definitely here, and with it, the Merry Christmas vs Happy Holiday controversy. It's likely that every Bay Ranch resident has an opinion about the appropriate greetings for the season, either, "What's the big deal," or, "Well, Happy Holidays is a way to be inclusive," or "How dare they eviscerate our Christmas?" (maybe not exactly using those words).

Probably everyone understands that people who don't care are not much into religion or Christmas. Everyone also realizes that "Happy Holidays" IS inclusive. So why is anyone threatened.

A little history may help. Religious affiliations in the United States have been and continue to be overwhelmingly Christian. Up until 1990, 87% of adults identified as Christian. By 2007, that percentage had dropped to 78.4%, more than one percent a year. My source indicates that this decline "appears to be continuing" (http://www.religioustolerance.org/chr_prac2.htm).

The shift away from Christianity was partly toward other religions. But the source mentioned above believes that after World War II, American adults increasingly abandoned organized religions in favor of secularism. This is what I believe is at the heart of the controversy about how to greet people during the holidays.

I suspect many people are like me in that their connections with others are not very diverse. Most of us probably know many more secular humanists or others who are not very connected to their religions than we know people of non-Christian faiths. So when we are greeted with, "Happy Holidays," we perceive that the greeting diminishes the "reason for the season." Heaven knows, there are plenty of other examples of xmas as a secular holiday as well.

So what can we do about it. Probably nothing. Chances are that many people who say, "Happy Holidays," really are secular humanists. Retail employees are following their employers' instructions to be inclusive. People with diverse circles of friends and acquaintances may say, "Happy Holidays" to genuinely include them all in the joy of the season.

Personally, I often say, "Merry Christmas," especially to a Christian. But I make my own choice.




