


HOA

NOTES FROM THE BAY RANCH OFFICE

Just to let you all know who have rv's, trailers or boats in the field, the \$50 fee is on hold but you must register at the office if you have one out there or see Brent(maintenance).

The office has launched a new, private Facebook page is called, "From the Office of Bay Ranch." Management useS it for important announcements about the daily business of the park. Contact the office to become a member. Note: this page does not replace "Neighbors," which is a social page. Contact Adam Pirhofer or Bob or Gin Lupton to become a member of "Neighbors."

The new management is serious about maintaining a clean and neat park. Managing garbage is a big part of this.

- Please, put ALL garbage in the dumpsters, even big and heavy items like furniture.
- DO NOT dump behind, beside or anywhere near the trash bins. Put the garbage in the bins.
- Put household trash in the smaller trash bins.
- Do not bring garbage to the bins on Monday morning. By that time, the bins are overflowing. Wait until Monday afternoon or later, when the bins are empty.
- Pick up for furniture, tree brush/limbs and other debris will be on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday only. Put out trash after 5:00 p.m, the day before.
- DO NOT DISPOSE OF TVS OR ELECTRONICS IN THE PARK. DO NOT PUT THEM IN OR BESIDE THE DUMPSTER. We get fined. Call pinellascounty.org/recycle to dispose of them.
- If you need help disposing of something, someone in the park may help you for a fee Rent Increase: Most residents already know that \$15 rent increase will go into effect starting January 1, 2019. Those in the non pet section paying \$557 will be paying \$572 starting January 1, 2019. Those on a corner lot or in the pet will be paying \$580. The increase for everyone is \$15.

The following information remains in force:

Rules: The Park has rules that everyone received and reviewed when they bought or rented their coach. <u>Please read and follow them</u>. Failure to follow rules is grounds for eviction, and management has shown that it is willing to evict.

No cars may be parked on the street at night. Failure to follow this rule may lead to the offending car being towed, resulting in fines. [Ed. Note: I can verify this. EVEN IF you run out to the street before they hook up your car to tow, you will get the fine.]

Cars parked on the street during the day should be staggered so emergency vehicles can pass by. Do not park on the grass or sidewalk.

Fires: Test your smoke detectors to make sure they work. Recommended action: purchase a fire extinguisher if you don't have one and know how to work it. If a fire starts, spray it

with the fire extinguisher immediately and GET OUT OF THE HOUSE. Fire destroys mobile homes very quickly.

Visitors: Reminder: that rent is based on one or two per household. Each person above the two must pay an additional \$30 a month, including visitors who stay over 30 days. Please be proactive about this and pay the money without first being reminded.

Other announcements:

The purified water dispenser at the clubhouse operates on its own schedule. After someone has filled containers, it may take the dispenser some time to regenerate enough water for more containers. There is a light on the dispenser that tells whether it is ready.

Some have questioned why the application fee is "so high." One reason is to help cover garbage fees, since new owners usually throw away most of the furniture and electronics.

Mr. Larson (the owner) calls the lawn service for lawn care on an as-needed basis. The park pays for lawn mowing, etc., once a month but the need sometimes goes unnoticed. If you notice the lawn needs trimming, please let the office know so they can call Mr. Larson.

Sometimes an automobile will leak oil onto our new, nice looking pavement, creating an eyesore. If you notice a leak by your house, call the office to have it cleaned up. Let's keep these streets looking nice!

Lost and Found Dog/Cat: If you have found a dog or cat, you can post on a site called pawboost.com or call Animal Service on Walsingham. If you call, Animal Services will come out, free of charge, to pick up an animal.

All Residents: Rules commonly broken:

- 1. Parking on grass or sidewalk, overnight on street, and/or every day. The Office must authorize overnight parking at the Clubhouse.
- 2. If you have someone living with you, make sure you have registered in the office.
- 3. Piling garbage in front of garbage bins. When you throw garbage, throw it to the back so when you open the door, it doesn't fall out and there is space.

Check mobile for cleaning, trim, awnings, driveway and/or painting.



FROM THE EDITOR







John recalls Boyd always followed up on any newcomers who were introduced at the weekly Monday morning Koffee Klatch sessions in the clubhouse. "As soon as the meeting was over Boyd was over talking to the new people to see if they would be interested in joining. He was always a good organizer and leader."

John, who was involved with horseshoes with Boyd for three and half years, said their season ran from January until May or when the snowbirds headed back north. "Boyd organized it at Bay Ranch and his good friend named 'Dewey' organized a league at Bay Aristocrat Village in Clearwater so we had some good competition."

When it came to instruction or a person wanted to improve his skills Boyd was always willing to help. "All they had to do was ask and he made himself available," said Trygstad.

He was quite a competitor too and competed in many high level tournaments when he returned home in Michigan. In the National Horseshoe Pitchers Association championships his best finish was runner-up one year. He also travelled around to various tournaments and instead of staying in motels Boyd and Jean the last couple of years travelled in style as he purchased an RV.

Boyd was also involved in the business aspect of horseshoes, and from 1985 he and Jean operated "the original" Lucky Shoe Pro Shop, selling official tournament horseshoes and supplies. And when Boyd travelled around to various tournaments, he and Jean usually set up shop.

He was also very religious. At Koffee Klatch meetings he usually handled an opening prayer and at the Thanksgiving or Christmas dinners in the clubhouse Boyd was usually called upon to deliver the blessing.

John said Boyd was a member of the Indian Rocks Baptist Church, and he recalls going with Boyd and Jean one Sunday to church. He was amazed to hear Boyd sing gospel hymns


