





Lost and Found Dog/Cat: If you have found a dog or cat, , you can post on a site called <u>pawboost.com</u> or call Animal Service on Walsingham. If you call, Animal Services will come out, free of charge, to pick up an animal. Any questions, please call Rose Kalp at 459-4808. We have sent quite a few animals to animal services.

PLEASE BE a responsible owner and have your animal fixed. This service is very low cost through animal services.

Snowbirds [and Vacationers]: Before you leave:

- 1. Please make sure you have someone doing your weeds, trees, etc., and keep mobile clean on the outside during the summer.
 - 2. Make sure anything that can be pitched around with the wind is put away.
 - 3. If you have a change of address, please make sure you notify the office.

All Residents: Rules commonly broken:

- 1. Parking overnight on street and/or every day.
- 2. If you have someone living with you, make sure you have registered in the office.
- 3. Do not pile garbage in front of garbage bins. When you throw garbage, throw it to the back so when you open the door, it doesn't fall out and there is space.
- 4. Check mobile for cleaning, trim, awnings, driveway and/or painting. We will have someone out soon checking your mobile.

Still relevant announcements Cliff made this year at Koffee Klatch:

- 1. Keep the dumpster area neat, especially on the weekends. If the dumpster is full, please put extras neatly beside it.
 - 2. Parking on the grass or sidewalk is against the rules. If necessary, park on the road.
- 3. Cars parked on the street after midnight will be towed. [Eds. Note: you have to pay the fine even if you run out before the tow truck takes your car away. We have nice neighbors who remind us when we are parked on the street at night.]
 - 4. The Office must authorize overnight parking at the Clubhouse.

I want to do something different this month. With our Snowbirds soon to return, I thought I would write about something our area is becoming famous for that some of you may not realize: the Craft Brewing Industry.

The Tampa Bay area is becoming a very well-known and respected region of craft brewers. Within just 5 miles of our park are a plethora of establishments that have great beers that are constantly changing, as well as a similar diversity of atmospheres to enjoy them in. Most of these breweries have outdoor beer gardens so we can enjoy the cooler weather coming along with our friends from the North along with a sample of new beers or just 1 or 2 favorites.

Having so many craft breweries in the area lets us "Pub Crawl, visiting several locations and sampling a "flight" of beers. A flight of 4 beers equals about 1 regular size glass of beer. Go to 4 establishments and enjoy 16 flavors yet have only 4 total beers. Just watch the alcohol contents.

These are some of the places that John and I have been to this month. I would write about all the different beers, but I think they won't let me fill the whole Review just on beer (would work for me though, let Carol know).

RAPP Brewing at 10930 Endeavour Way, Seminole. This place is just down the road off Bryan Dairy Rd. It is a nice place in an industrial park. They keep expanding by taking over more units. Great selection of beer, always changing. Focusing on people and beer, it is a great place to sit and socialize with friends. The staff are always willing to teach a novice a thing or two about beers.

Willard's Tap Room at 12500 Starkey Rd just before the railroad tracks. These folks are not brewers, but have over 40 craft beers on tap, plus a bunch of bottles. Not a very large place, it has a fun atmosphere, with a supply of board and table games available to play. Fun for four to have an energetic evening. You can bring food or have it delivered here. Makes beer and snacks a personal choice. Great place for friends to hang out.

Barley Mow Brewing at 518 W Bay Dr in Largo has a small inside seating area with nice outside patio. They have a small selection of brews plus some guest taps. They also have a full bar for simple cocktails. This is not a craft cocktail joint but has a lot of top shelf liquors. Weekends feature live music along with a food truck. Right next door is a great BBQ joint. This establishment will be moving soon, so try it out before they expand.

St Petersburg has a large number of places downtown and spreading from there, with a variety of fun environments to pick from--sports to music to friends. Most have food available or trucks showing up. With so many to choose from, you can easily plan to visit several on foot when you're in town for various events

The St. Pete breweries we visited were: St Pete Brewing at 544 1st Ave N, Spillane Ale Works (PAWS) at 1962 1st Ave S, Cage Brewing at 2001 1st Ave S and 3 Daughters Brewing at 222 22nd St S. All are great places, but each has its own personality.

Music and art are big influences for a lot of the folks, which is evident at the last place I will talk about, a little further away in Dunedin. **Woodwright Brewing at 985 Douglas Ave** features an open bluegrass music night outside every 1st and 3rd Thursday of the month. Chairs are arranged in a semicircle to encourage anyone to join in. Add the type and quality of beer, and it is a nice way to listen to some good music and watch a sunset. Check out the woodworking they do there as well.

If beer is more than just cold flavored water with alcohol content to you, you have hit the jackpot. This area has so many micro-breweries and speciality beer pubs, .I have barely scratched the surface. And you don't even have to leave the area. If you're willing to take a trip to Tampa or Sarasota, your choices grow even more. The variety of ideas for new beers is as great as the number individuals running these places. If sitting down and talking to people about the idea behind flavors intrigues, these places are great. You can actually meet the creators. Just start within our own little world and see what is out there. Until we meet again, Bottoms Up!
