Each homeowner will be receiving a copy of the proposed updates. The draft document will be reviewed and approved at the April 21, 2015 Board Meeting.

Many of our snowbirds will be leaving for the north in the next few weeks. Here is a checklist of items to do before you leave –

- 1. Make sure someone is in charge of your property and notify the Association who it is.
- 2. Update your contact address with the Association before you leave. Forms can be found in this news bulletin or at the clubhouse and may be left in the depository at the clubhouse.
- 3. Change the batteries in your sprinkler timer.
- 4. Make sure ALL items around your home have been stowed. During hurricane season, a mat or mail basket can become a projectile and do damage to your home or your neighbors.

Watering days are Tuesday/Saturday for odd number houses and Thursday/Sunday for even number houses. Be sure your watering times are correct. Timers stay on STANDARD TIME throughout the year.

A reminder when you are using the clubhouse, please take a minute and pick up after yourself before you leave. We are finding food on the floor and other debris. This is your home too!!

I will be heading north April 18 however, I plan to attend the operational meetings on Mondays by telephone to stay current and involved. For those heading north, have a safe trip and for everyone make it a great summer!!




Attention Snowbirds and Travelers

Ray was in construction and Angie is a supervisor in the Department of Homeland Security. They enjoy leisure time at the beach and/or fishing.




