### Tello All,

By the time you read this I will have been back in Blue Jay for a couple of weeks, hopefully enjoying the warmth and sun after the cool fall up north. I look forward to another peaceful and warm winter with friends.

I wanted to bring a couple of issues to everyone's attention after the Hurricane. First, you may be eligible, if you had damage to your property, to apply for FEMA Funding to help with cleanup. I have the following information for you from FEMA. Hopefully, if you need assistance, you can get some help here.

As storm victims struggle to recover from Hurricanes Harvey & Irma and fires in the west, community associations should strongly encourage residents to register for assistance from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA).

Homeowners who need financial assistance to repair their primary residence, temporary shelter, or medical assistance should apply for FEMA Individual Disaster Assistance. FEMA asks survivors who have internet access to register for aid at DisasterAssistance.gov. If you can't get online, call 800-621-3362 or 800-462-7585 (TTY). Registering will enable FEMA to begin the process of determining eligibility for aid and services.

I also wanted to bring to your attention a new storm related scam. There are unscrupulous individuals and groups that may contact you with the offer of "assisting you in filing insurance, FEMA, or other storm related claims." Please be aware that these folks are not looking to help you but to line their own pockets with your cash. There have already been instances of elderly folks having claims registered in their names but payable to the accounts of others. Please be aware that this type of thing is going on, as well as the usual repair schemes that arise after every natural disaster. Protect yourself by being vigilant with what you sign. If you do not feel completely comfortable with the person you are dealing with, just say no. If you are not sure, talk to someone you trust.

# Help for Severe Aortic Stenosis



Severe aortic stenosis is a narrowed aortic heart valve that doesn't open and close properly, reducing blood flow to the rest of the body.

Morton Plant Hospital is now enrolling eligible patients in the Medtronic Evolut R low-risk trial, which investigates the safety and effectiveness of a transcatheter aortic valve replacement (TAVR) system in patients with severe aortic stenosis who are at a low surgical mortality risk. TAVR is a minimally invasive alternative to open-heart surgery used to treat failing aortic heart valves in patients with severe aortic stenosis. Morton Plant Hospital was chosen as the first hospital in Tampa Bay to offer the TAVR procedure for patients with severe aortic stenosis who were at an intermediate or high surgical mortality risk. Our team has completed more than 700 TAVR procedures over the last five years.


