# From the Board of Directors

By the time you read this I will have been back in Blue Jay for a couple of weeks, hopefully enjoying the warmth and sun after the cool fall up north. I look forward to another peaceful and warm winter with friends.

It has been a very quiet month in Blue Jay, which while it makes the Monthly Media message short, it sure is great news for me. Most Monday meetings were less than 15 minutes long. There have been few slips in the box and sometimes none. We continue to address every issue that is put in the box in a timely manner, usually on the day we get it. Many thanks to Bill Iverson for being on top of this.



Our landscapers are now on a bi-weekly schedule, which should make shrub trimming and weed control much easier. If you have any issue that needs addressing there is a large supply of reporting forms in the clubhouse. Fill one out and put "put it in the box."

Remember, our November meeting, which is scheduled for November 19th, is a "Members" meeting, and your presence or proxy is required to allow for the budget to be passed. Please plan on being there. You will receive a mailing which includes the budget immediately after the October 15th Board Meeting.

This year's budget comes with some unfortunate news. For the first time since I was elected to the Board we have been required to raise monthly fees to homeowners. We have been able to absorb the yearly increases in basic items for several years, but in doing so have gradually increased the funding from reserves in our budget. But this year increases rose to the point where they could no longer be handled in that manner, and needed to be funded by an increase. At the same time we were hit by an extraordinary 46% increase in our waste disposal contract, which added \$4/month all by itself. We are required to fund our expenses and not provide a budget that includes deficit spending. We had no choice but to increase fees to cover all of the cost increases.

Sue and I are looking forward to seeing you all once again. Roland





ant to handle your money better? Most of us do. The Motley Fool website advises breaking these three bad habits:

**\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*** 

- Paying bills late. A few days or weeks may not seem to matter, but you'll be hit with late fees, interest, and damage to your credit rating. Do your best to pay all your bills on time. Set up reminders so you're always on schedule. Automatic payment is one reliable option.
- Accumulating too much debt. Not all debt is bad, as long as you manage it sensibly and pay it off in a reasonable time. If you can't pay off your credit cards and other debt by the end of the month, set up a budget that helps you monitor and control your spending before debt gets out of control and hurts your credit rating.
- **Not saving.** Putting money away can be difficult, but not saving any money is a mistake. # When and where to pay cash

- **Tipping.** Tipping in cash instead of adding it to your bill ensures that your server gets the full amount.
- Farmer's markets. Many vendors have credit card machines nowadays, but not all of them. And the machines can always go down because of a power outage or spotty Wi-Fi. Keep cash handy so you don't miss out.
- Minimum purchases. Coffee shops and other venues frequently have a \$5 or \$10 minimum for credit card purchases. Paying cash ensures you don't buy more than you need in order to meet the minimum.
- **Private transactions.** You want to buy a special gift for your spouse, but you don't want him or her seeing it on a credit card statement. Use cash to keep the transaction secret.






