Help for Severe Aortic Stenosis



Severe aortic stenosis is a narrowed aortic heart valve that doesn't open and close properly, reducing blood flow to the rest of the body.

Morton Plant Hospital is now enrolling eligible patients in the Medtronic Evolut R low-risk trial, which investigates the safety and effectiveness of a transcatheter aortic valve replacement (TAVR) system in patients with severe aortic stenosis who are at a low surgical mortality risk. TAVR is a minimally invasive alternative to open-heart surgery used to treat failing aortic heart valves in patients with severe aortic stenosis. Morton Plant Hospital was chosen as the first hospital in Tampa Bay to offer the TAVR procedure for patients with severe aortic stenosis who were at an intermediate or high surgical mortality risk. Our team has completed more than 700 TAVR procedures over the last five years.

ere is an article about recycling. There have been too many articles thrown in the recycle bin that need to be taken out all the time.



ATTENTION - RECYCLING PROCEEDURES

This article is to inform new unit owners, renters and long time residents of the rules for what goes and what doesn't go in the recycle dumpster. Even though there are explicit signs on the recycling dumpster there have been many items tossed in that don't belong there.

First, newspapers and card board are welcome. Please break down the cardboard boxes so they don't take up too much room. Pizza containers that have grease on them cannot be tossed in. Plastic bottles are welcome. Plastic bottles must have the caps removed so when they go through the sorter the bottles don't explode and the cap then becomes a projectile. This is dangerous to all the workers. Plastic bags of ANY kind cannot be put in the recycle bin. Don't take your recycle items to the bin in a plastic bag and toss it all in. Empty the bag and put it in the garbage dumpster.

Glass bottles, tin cans and jars are recyclable. Aluminum cans i.e. pop, beer are put in the tubs beside the dumpster. These cans are crushed and taken to a place that gives us a rebate and the money then goes to the social club.

It only takes a minute to review these simple rules to comply with the recycling people. Many times, residents have had to dumpster dive to place items in the proper container. If we all do our part, we won't have our recycling privileges taken away.

Bird Dinners - it seems for forever. As well he is famous for his tasty bread pudding.


He volunteers in both his churches in Ohio and Florida.
