You Can Do It Exercise

ince the beginning of November, our morning exercise group began to loosen up and warm up again. We are using a similar walking program as we did last season. We are going to have a new addition to our sale this year. We will have a small boutique set up in the library. Some of you have said you have some nice things to contribute but neglected to do so because you felt that our regular pricing was too low for such items. Well, people, now is your opportunity. Susan Logan and Mae Webster will be in charge of the boutique and both have said they have several items to contribute. However, most of us could not fit into anything of theirs and we will need a variety of sizes to make our boutique work. Because we are limited in space, we only want clothing, shoes, purses and perhaps better class jewelry. Numbers in the News

Stay-at-home fathers on the rise for diverse reasons

More fathers are staying home to take care of their children than ever before, according to the Pew Research Center. Some 2 million dads are at home full-time (though not all of them are their children's primary caregivers). In 1989, only 1.1 million fathers were stay-at-home dads. Economic reasons may be part of the trend, since 47 percent of them live under the poverty line, and daycare can be expensive.

They tend to have less education: Fourteen percent don't have a high school diploma, compared to 3 percent with at least a bachelor's degree. And they may be at home due to disability—the Pew report notes that 35 percent are ill or disabled, although that figure is down from 1989, when 56 percent of stay-at home fathers were ill or disabled.

But many fathers stay home not because they have to, but because they want to. Researchers at Pew found that 12 percent of dads today freely choose to stay at home to care for their families, up from 5 percent in 1989.

Is cash losing its cachet?

We may not be moving toward a cashless society, but for some people paying with plastic is the preferred way to go. A survey from CreditCard.com found that 51 percent of adults under 30 will use a credit or debit card for purchases under \$5, while 77 percent of people 50 or older prefer to pay cash when buying something for \$5 or less.

Debit cards are more popular than credit cards among the younger generation by a 3-to-1 margin, and hold a 2-to-1 lead among users of all ages. Americans held balances on credit cards in the amount of half a trillion dollars by the end of the first half of 2014, according to the Federal Reserve Bank of New York.

The cost of littering adds up

Trash and litter are unsightly—and expensive. Litter cleanup costs the country approximately \$11.5 billion every year, according to a 2009 study from Keep America Beautiful. That includes costs to businesses cleaning up their properties—\$9.1 billion—as well as state, city, and county expenses that come to more than \$1.3 billion, and the estimated \$241 million that educational facilities have to spend cleaning up sports areas and school grounds.
