Park Observations

everal Board of Directors have been getting concerns about several things going on in the park covered by our rules but not being followed.

We thought this might be a good time to gently review some areas of concern.

First the posted speed limit sign. Many of us see them but go right on by at our own speed, not the limit set by the sign. Please observe the speed limit.

This creates problems for us which brings us to our second concern and is tied in with the first. We are having more small children visiting our park and we welcome them and love them all. If our speed limit is not observed we put these small children at great risk. By the same token we need to observe the rule, saying an adult with all children at all times and all places. We have to be more aware parents and grandparents of the children playing in the street and using scooters and trikes to go to and from the pool. They need to be kept within arms length of you at all times. It has been observed parents at the end of the street and the little ones halfway to the pool. People backing out of their carport cannot see clearly those little ones on the bike and we are making a situation that could be disastrous and the whole park would be devastated. Please try to do a better job of supervision this season.

We all remember from our rules that guests and family visiting need that request on file in the office and approved before they arrive.

The same is true of sub-leases. That provision is in both our documents and rules. We have had several infractions of this in the past and the board can prevent occupancy until the documents are submitted and approved by the board. Please do not make us have to do that.

Another violation observed is parking on the grass. Florida grass at its best is fragile and it only takes a few times to damage it. Park on the street and if your guest is going to be staying overnight there are forms at the office to request permission for them to park at the clubhouse.

Each of us has the responsibility of helping the park keep these rules. If you see an infraction politely ask the responsible parties to correct whatever infraction is happening rather than trying to notify one of the board members to handle the situation. Then follow up with a note to the office stating the date, time and infraction, so they can be recorded. If continued incidents occur then board can take remedial action. They have to be recorded, not word of mouth. We



are a cooperative, so that means each member cooperates in the operation of the park.

This is meant to be a friendly reminder of some of our rules being ignored and a request of cooperation in the true sense of the word.


