

## **DIAL DIRECTORY PHONE NUMBERS**

The Dial Directory phone numbers for Phase I are available for "import to your smart phones. There are two files on the Directors' web page.

One is designed for "Import" into Google Contacts for those who have their contacts on Google. Click on the CSV file and then select "Save As" and save the file on your computer. Open Google Contacts, Import the file. Once imported, go to Contacts on your smart phone and press the three dots or Settings and select "Sync Now". Phone numbers will be downloaded to your smart phone.

If you do not have Google Contacts, the CSV file can be downloaded to your computer and imported to your smart phone. Check your manual for procedure. The VCF, which is a vCard file, can be imported directly to your smart phone. Save the VCF file on your computer. Plug the USB end of your smart phone charger cable into the computer and the micro plug into the smart phone. Use your computer "File Explorer" (should display when you connect the phone to the computer) then copy and paste the VCF file from the computer to your smart phone. The smart phone will know what to do with the VCF file. If all of this is strange to you, next time your grandchildren come for a visit, perhaps they could do it for you.

On March 13, 2020 the board of directors took preventive action to help protect our residents from the spread of the coronavirus. unpleasant odors, and those are just your likely problems. Water leaks, strong winds, and even burglars may present some interesting problems with which to deal with upon your return. Don't come home to a troublesome situation; take these steps to ensure a happy homecoming.

- Clean out your refrigerator, unplug and leave door ajar.
- Run water in all faucets for 10 minutes to flush system, then put olive oil (about one capful) in trap to seal in moisture
- Turn off the water
- Unplug the hot water heater/Turn off the breaker
- Set the air conditioner between 78 and 84 degrees and the dehumidifier at 45
- Open all of the interior doors to circulate air throughout the home including cabinet doors under the sinks.
- Empty dishwasher and leave door unlatched.
- Cover toilets and tanks with plastic and secure with tape. You may want to pour a few drops of bleach in the toilet water.
- Put stoppers in all the drains.
- Close all of the curtains and blinds to keep the heat out
- Install surge protectors throughout your home
- Unplug all audio/visual components, including the phone and cable lines
- Clean out gutters and drainage
- Have all cracks sealed and all caulking at windows and doors inspected and repaired as necessary
- Bring in outdoor furniture, trash containers or items that could blow away
- Stop newspaper deliveries until your return
- · Forward your mail to your off-season home
- Temporarily discontinue phone, internet, and cable services.
- Have someone check on your home periodically and open your Door to let in fresh air.
- Post Emergency Contact Numbers on your Fridge in case we need to contact you. Enjoy your Summer and we will see you again in the Fall.


n the third Saturday of each month, we collect what you have donated and deliver it to the Food Pantry that week.
