

#### PHASE 1 & 2 OUTDOOR WATER USAGE

Tatering of lawns should be done with consideration for the whole community. There is only a single water meter that monitors the water usage in both Briar Creek Phase I & II.

The water bill reflects the water usage in both communities. When lawns and other outdoor plants are watered, to the point that water is running down the street into the storm drain, this is a waste of a precious natural resource as well as a lack of concern for fellow residents who pay through their monthly condo fee for the water used in both communities.

There are water restrictions in place by Pinellas County. Usually this time of the year and other times, when rain is in short supply, residents are required to follow county policy concerning the use of water, to ensure that there is a sufficient supply for everyone in the County.

Residents need to follow the restrictions, and if water is running down the street, it indicates that the ground can no longer absorb it and the water should be turned off. It is better to water several times than try to get it done all at once and waste water.

I have been called out several times with what residents believe is a water leak only to find that someone's lawn or plants are being over watered and I have to request them to stop. I ask all residents to show respect for their fellow residents and our precious natural resources and use water responsibly.



#### **New Inspection Process Update**

We're on our way to the start of 12-month home inspections. We have approximately 105 homeowners that have already chosen their inspection month, so we still have a way to go on that front. Here's what you need to know for the month of July:

Inspections will begin October 1st, and the cut-off date for selecting the month you want your home inspected is September 1st. If I haven't heard from you by then, I will be choosing your inspection date. Let me repeat: IF YOU HAVE NOT CONTACTED ME BY SEPTEMBER 1ST WITH YOUR PREFERRED INSPECTION MONTH, I WILL SELECT THE MONTH FOR YOU. I don't imagine you snowbirds want a summer month for the inspection of your home; please let me know NOW so I don't have to choose the date for you.

There are only three inspection dates still available for the month of April, and they're reserved for snowbirds only. If you're a year-round resident and haven't picked a month yet, please choose any month from May through December.

The inspection sheet will be all-new. It will be just one page (instead of the current 2-part carbonless form), which will make it clearer and easier to understand. You'll still need to sign it and return it to the Director's office, but you're encouraged to make a copy of it for your records.

Why these changes? Mainly, it's impossible to inspect all 317 homes and wrap up the necessary paperwork in just one or two months. In fact, I'm continuously working on the inspection process. So I asked myself, "if this is truly a year-round job, why not spread out the responsibilities over all 12 months?" Many residents contact me every year, asking that there inspection be delayed for any number of reasons. Have you found it difficult scheduling one of the power-washing businesses to clean your home? WE ALL HAVE! That's because we're ALL trying to get them at the same time. Making this a 12-month event will reduce the "log jam" of work for these companies, as well as our own frustrations in trying to get the work done.



It is a good idea to routinely pick up a few non-perishable supplies each time you shop during Hurricane season. Once warnings are issued, grocery shelves may quickly empty. If you opt to go to a shelter you may want to bring some food and water for yourself. Have enough pet food on hand, too. Not all shelter allow pets. Most stores have hurricane preparedness information near the entrance/exit – grab one.

urricane season has begun. There is no need to prepare for a hurricane until it threatens our area.



#### WRONG FALSE YOU WILL BE A STATISTIC

If you wait likely all of the things you need will not available, you will rush to prepare or forget something. **Prepare in advance**. You can buy extra water now, it does not go stale during the hurricane season and you will have it afterwards to use up.

On the mybriarcreek web site under the Disaster Mgt. tab is a link to Pinellas Emergency Management. There is a Hurricane Booklet with printing instructions which includes information friendly to Briar Creek. Where local Pet Hotels and Hotels in our area, some of which for a nominal fee will hold a reservation also area evacuation centers.

Important phone numbers and a Grab-N-Go packet, Evacuation routes, preparations for Pet Safety, Storm Survival Kit, Home Site Precautions and Radio Hurricanes stations.

The web page also has information on Hurricane Essential Kits, Flood Map, and information on what to do for Hurricanes, Lightning, Storm Surge, and the Aftermath. Also a Hurricane Tacking chart. **Don't wait, be ready.** 



Your Copy Kit should contain a copy of every bill you pay, such as Electric, Cable, Telephone, Passport and other essential information; place that in the Grab-N-Go Kit. They all contain account numbers and information you will need in the event a Hurricane visist Briar Creek. Please don't become part of our Memoriam Web Page, plan now.

#### **Some Internet Tips**

These may prove helpful when surfing the web and especially the mybriarcreek website. Our website may have changes published daily and in some cases updates made to one of the web pages more than once in the same day. This is because the webmaster is a resident volunteer with immediate access to the web server rather than a support service when scheduling changes can take time.

Under "Tools" on most internet browsers there is "Internet Options" that will allow you to indicate you want to "Start with the Home Page" of a website. You can also check the box for "Delete Browsing History" and this will clear any previously stored web information. Internet Browsers, in order to speed display, will store web page files in a temporary folder on your hard drive. When you revisit that web page it can display the old files stored and not the most



recent file that was changed. If in doubt to ensure you are seeing the correct information when returning to the same website, especially the same day, press the "F5" function key which will refresh your view. Some prefer to retain their browsing history so they can use the drop down display so the "F5" key is the sure way to know you are current.

See something on a web page you want to copy and save. Position your mouse cursor symbol to the immediate left of the area or text, depress and hold the left mouse button, shade in the area you wish to copy and let go of the mouse button. Immediately press the "CTRL" key and the "C" key on your keyboard at the same time. Open a text page such as a new Word blank page. Press the "CTRL" key and the "V" key on the keyboard and you will have the information which was just stored in your "Buffer". This includes graphics if that was shaded. Depending on web designs or pages this sometimes may vary.

Want to save the web page you are on so you can return later. While on the web page click the menu item "File" and then in the dropdown window look for "Send" click and select "Send to Desktop". An icon for that page will be created on your desktop. You can then return to that webpage immediately. Be aware when using that Desktop Icon again you may have to employ the "F5" function as something may have changed since you save the icon. To remove the Icon point the cursor to the Icon, press the right mouse button and click deplete. The shortcut is deleted.



#### Travel Tales

lorida summer weather makes a good time to escape north to cooler weather, but snow was not really on our wish list. But that's what we encountered this year on a Caravan bus trip from Mt Rushmore, through Yellowstone and the Grand Tetons to Salt Lake City. Well, there was snow on the ground, especially at Mt Rushmore; in fact the site had been closed to all visitors two days before our visit because of it. But we were lucky, despite the snow piled around us, only some walking trails were closed and our tour was able to go ahead as planned.

This was our first long (7 day) bus tour and we were very happy with the company, the (brand new) bus, the hotel accommodation, the tour director and our fellow travelers. Fortunately it was too early in the season for any screaming babies or noisy school kids.

We arrived in Rapid City, N. Dakota, on a grey rather dismal afternoon and what we saw of the town on the way to our hotel from the airport looked about as gray and dismal. The next day was a different story, under a clear western blue sky, the town looked attractive and worth a visit, especially to see the avenue where every corner featured a life size statue of a US President.

We spent the first day visiting the awesome Mt Rushmore, an absolutely amazing creation, and then went on the Indian Crazy Horse stone carving, an even more immense project that is projected to take another 100 years or so to complete.

After that it was back to Rapid City, the Presidents' statues, and a good dinner before getting ready to head out to Yellowstone the next day.

This was our longest day of driving, some 400 miles, but we were enjoying such glorious sunshine that the tour guide took us in to see the immense Devil's Tower in Wyoming, a weird geological artifact and a great photo opportunity. We had lunch at the gorgeous old Sheridan Inn in Wyoming.

Also that day we stopped at the Little Bighorn Battlefield Memorial in Montana, a very moving site with memorials to both the US and the Indian sides and a small museum with a large collection of memorabilia. We spent the night in Billings, Montana, where the Lewis and Clark expeditions had camped, so we brushed up on our history about that expedition.

The next day we entered into Yellowstone after a beautiful drive through Paradise Valley with towering mountain ranges on each side. Lunch was in Mammoth close to the northern park entrance and it was enjoyed in the company of the elk meandering through the village.

My take is that Yellowstone is fabulous place for viewing wildlife (we were visiting early enough in the season that the major animal groups had not migrated into the high pastures), the valleys and meadows were beautiful, and the geological features, the hot springs, the geysers, the mud pools were fascinating to look at but the land immediately surrounding these features was drab colored and barren. This was true of the area surrounding the Old Faithful



Inn where we stayed for 2 nights. The Inn itself is an awesome wood structure, with rather basic accommodation. The Park wants it to stay as original as possible, so no Wi-Fi and no TV. This meant that after dinner, guests stayed in the lobby area and the balconies above to chat, mingle, listen to the music, play cards etc. All very different to a stay in a modern hotel.

Our second day in Yellowstone gave us a tour of the "lower loop", beautiful waterfalls, grand old hotels on Yellowstone Lake and, of course, more animals, and more opportunities to see Old Faithful spout into the sky.

The next morning we left Yellowstone and headed towards the Grand Tetons, and the highlight of the day was a 10 mile float down the Snake River on a rubber raft. This was the boat crew's second trip of the season and snow melt made the water very high, so some people were a bit leery, but we all made the trip and loved it. So peaceful.

We got to Jackson in the late afternoon. What a neat town! Of course we headed to the Million Dollar Cowboy Bar to enjoy a drink sitting on a saddle at the bar. The only thing was the saddle wasn't very comfortable so we moved to a table. Wonder if this was planned to allow more tourists a turn in the saddle seats?

The following morning was our last day of driving, as we headed out for Salt Lake City in Utah. We thoroughly enjoyed a stop at the National Oregon Trail Museum, and their "virtual reality" wagon ride. By the afternoon we were gazing at the Salt Lake City temple complex and had enough time to have a short visit and a look inside. The tour sponsored a farewell dinner at the Hilton where we were all staying and most of the group was getting ready to fly home the next day.

We had arranged a late evening flight for the next day, so we had extra time the next day to visit the Family Search Center, and then we took a quirky tram tour of the town. What an absolutely beautiful city...really worth a second visit.

We'd certainly do another bus tour, and would recommend the tour and the tour company, Caravan Tours. All the states we visited were new to me and we saw some beautiful country. Meanwhile, we're going to search for more vacation options in Utah.
