## **BOARD BUSINESS and UPDATES**

#### From the Desk of - Jeff Clark, President

Trecently drove down one of our streets, when I noticed that some of the homes had no visible house numbers. Then I drove down it again, counting the actual "numberless" homes. Of the 18 homes on the street, fully HALF had no numbers at all. Of the remaining homes, 4 had numbers that were hidden, too small to be clearly read from the street, or were difficult to read because they didn't contrast with their background. I know that YOU know where you live, but if I can't read your house number, then how can an emergency responder, like an EMT or sheriff's deputy? For your own personal safety, please make sure your home has numbers that are large enough and legible enough to be read clearly by everyone.

As our homes age, they begin to need repairs and maintenance that you may not have considered in the past. One of these is the brick planter in front of your home. I see many that are coming apart as the mortar begins to deteriorate, or have settled so much that they're barely visible. Please take a look at your planter and assess its condition; does it need repair or replacing? If you're not sure, contact me and we'll look at it together to determine how it will fare during next year's inspection.

Uly mowing schedule includes our weekly summer visits on the 6th, 13th, 20th and 27th. Please remember to protect your plastic skirting with a brick barrier, and stage flags of some sort around specific areas you do not wish to have mowed or weed whipped.

As mentioned at the June BOD meeting, Safety Harbor has sent us a list of trees that need to be trimmed so that the umbrella does not impact the refuse & fire vehicles. 15' or more is the minimum height mandated from the road surface.

The 46 trees identified are posted on Betty's interweb publication and in the Clubhouse on the bulletin board across from the shuffleboard info. We know that some of the work has been accomplished already, but I must encourage each resident to take this seriously since the City has a right to fine each of us if we don't comply within a reasonable time.

June 20th I head back to NH for a few months of wild turkeys, moose, porcupines and a few hungry bears who hang out on our residential acreage. Of course energetic 13 & 9 year old grandsons are a huge draw as well. I plan to return the third week of September if all goes well.

I have not asked anyone to stand-in for me regarding the lawns, trees and landscape responsibilities. I have posted my personal cell phone number on the Director's bulletin board near the office door. I will answer my phone whenever possible but I remind you that I will be 1,365 miles from Cedar Elm Drive; I ask that you call only with reasonable requests that you think I can impact from that distance.

Conversely I suggest that you share your observations, opinions and yes complaints via e-mail so I can review and forward to the Principals at Alexander's and/or our irrigation firm so they can fully understand your feelings by reading your words directly. Please remember a friendly compliment goes a long way with our service providers if you can find it in your heart while understanding the huge tasks that they wrestle with weekly to keep our Community as beautiful as it is.

## **Roofing Project**

opefully without any further rain delays, the roofing project concerning the clubhouse & garage should/could be completed by this time. The board would like to thank Leveryone for their patience during the roofing project. Currently, the flat roof on the garage is completed with only the finish metal to be installed on the mansards. With regards to the clubhouse roof, the main flat roof is completed to include the raising of all of the hvac units as required by code. The two lower flat roofs to include the front entrance and rear poolside roof was found to be leaking and needed to be replaced. These two lower roofing areas were not in the original bid on the roof replacements. When the metal located over theses flat roofs were removed, there were existing issues that needed to be addressed. When getting into commercial roofing projects there are always some unforeseen issues that come up. The front lower flat roof was found to be leaking for some time and had caused some roof decking and mansard decking to be rotted. The rear flat roof (pool side) was found to be in real bad shape whereas the roof has been leaking for some time causing some major damage to the decking and roof supports. Therefore, the board of directors found it necessary to have lower roofs replaced at an added expense to the project. Once the lower roofs are replaced, the metal for the mansards will be ordered and installed.



#### Briar Creek 1 and Briar Creek 2 Website Changes Joe Simpson

ssociations such as ours (BC1,BC2) <u>must have a website with</u> protected information such as minutes, financials, and contracts.

This is extract from the law

1. By July 1, 2018, an association with 150 or more units which does not manage timeshare units shall post digital copies of the documents specified in subparagraph 2. on its website.

a. The association's website must be:

(I) An independent website or web portal wholly owned and operated by the association; or (II) A website or web portal operated by a third-party provider with whom the association owns, leases, rents, or otherwise obtains the right to operate a web page, subpage, web portal, or collection of subpages or web portals dedicated to the association's activities and on which required notices, records, and documents may be posted by the association.

b. The association's website must be accessible through the Internet and must contain a subpage, web portal, or other protected electronic location that is inaccessible to the general public and accessible only to unit owners and employees of the association.

c. Upon a unit owner's written request, the association must provide the unit owner with a username and password and access to the protected sections of the association's website that contain any notices, records, or documents that must be electronically provided.

To view the <u>Board of Directors Minutes-Financial-Contracts</u> link on the website, you now have to be authorized. Everything else on website is the same (can be viewed by anyone).

You must be a Briar Creek owner to be authorized.

To become authorized do the following from the website:

- 1. click on the Board of Directors Minutes-Financial-Contracts link
- 2. click on Request Access Click Here
- 3. You will see a form appear on your screen
- 4. Complete the form and click on Submit Form

When you are approved, you will receive an email message containing username and password. You must fill in these fields before logging on. You have to re-enter the username and password if you leave and come back.

Approvals are usually returned in 1 day. You only need to be authorized one time!

For any problems, send email to 'webmaster' or 'webmaster2' (on the website). Thank you for your cooperation.




