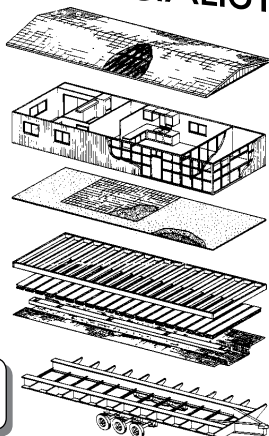

Make sure you keep the calendar handy since holiday time is busy with caroling this year and other holiday activities. It is always such a joyous time of the year as we bring another year to a close. If you have not attended coffee hour on Wednesday morning, come join us; great way to meet people and make new friends.

Clubhouse Reservation

Gene Arend

The Phase I clubhouse is available for personal reservation by owners for private events. Under our Deed Restrictions (by-laws) the event has restrictions if used for commercial events. Check with Gene to understand these restrictions. If Alcohol is consumed, even if it's BYOB (Bring Your Own Beverage) the use of Alcohol on common elements must be approved by two director's. You may not provide or sell Alcoholic beverages in the clubhouse as our Insurance does not include a clause for sale or distribution of Alcohol and you will be personally liable.

On the mybriarcreek.com website under the Phase I section on the Clubhouse Tab is an online form used to reserve the clubhouse. The calendar is up to date for at least 18 months and is posted showing events previously reserved by the Association, Social Club, Owners, or offered to charity or local governmental agencies.

If the date you desire is taken complete the online request form and we will see if we can make arrangements to accommodate multiple requests. Once completing the online reservation form, which is self-explanatory, it is automatically forwarded and begins the reservation process. Your date will be tentatively posted pending final approval. Be sure to read the Clubhouse Usage Agreement. This outlines your responsibility for care and use of the clubhouse and also has the Alcohol request included.

The online form will require you to confirm you have read and you accept and agree to the rules for clubhouse use. This procedure is in place to make the clubhouse available to all owners while also reserving dates for Social and Community use. It also ensures the use is covered under the Association Insurance blanket. Help us help you plan your private event.

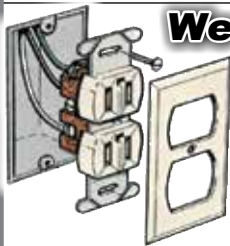

The Briar Creek Phase II community has the distinct privilege of an RV parking lot for the use of its residents. There are only 24 spaces and all are filled at this time. A few years ago a new form was initiated. We are asking all people currently using the RV Park to fill out and sign the new form and get a copy of the rules and regulations for storing your boat or RV in the lot. Leave your form at the secretary's office in the clubhouse. A copy of the rules is on the front gate of the lot. Be sure that your space is clean, mowed and in pristine condition. You cannot change your space without the express approval of the board. Soon the Board will be following up with people who either haven't filled out the form or aren't doing their part to keep the lot clean and mowed. The Board hopes that everyone will comply and they won't have to chase you down.

Last spring we signed a contract with a new lawn company. The cost was much higher than it used to be. One of the reasons is that people are putting things out on their lawn without checking with the Board to be sure that the lawnmowers can get around. TV dishes are a big culprit. Now the men have to use weed whackers to get around all the poles which is more time consuming than just riding the lawn mower down the area between homes. If you are planning to put a new TV dish in your yard, please speak with a Board member first, they can help you negotiate with the dish company to be sure it is in a spot that works for reception but is also not impeding the lawnmowers. This will help keep our lawn maintenance costs down.

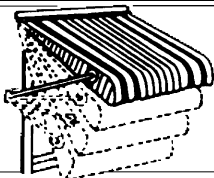

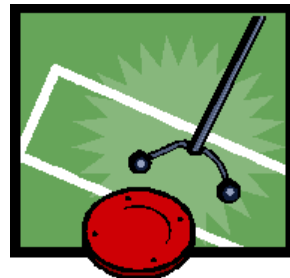

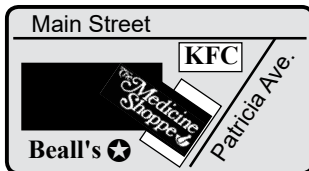
