









ou will be receiving in the mail from Progressive Management your General/Limited Proxy. It is important that all owners submit their Proxy for our Annual Meeting scheduled for 10:00 AM, Monday December 7, 2015. Your completed SIGNED Proxy ensures the Board of Directors will be allowed to conduct business during 2016. Unsigned proxies will not be counted.

Be sure you vote for each issue as explained in the Proxy. A quorum of owners (159 of 317) is required to pass the listed issues. Only one Proxy is valid per property. If you own two properties, submit a proxy for each one. Please show your Unit Number, then date and SIGN your Proxy before submitting. The signature must be any owner on the title. If you change, or have changed the title or mailing address since purchasing, you need to let Progressive Management know.

You must submit your Proxy prior to 10:00 AM on December 7, 2015.

There are several ways to submit your Proxy:

- 1. Drop in mail slot at Clubhouse Directors Office; or
- 2. Give to Jo Ann Barr any time, or drop off at 106 Cedar Elm Dr, put in black mail box at back door; or
- 3. Mail to Progressive Management.

It is recommended that your Proxy be dropped at the Directors Office or given to Jo Ann Barr. Mailing slows the tally process. Early submission insures there are enough proxies received to conduct business during the 2016 year.



exciting pastimes, mountain hiking, walking and sightseeing, they missed their family ties, and decided to move back to Florida.

Phil was born in southern Indiana, in the small town of Farmersburg, population around 350. His parents, like many who lived in that area of the Midwest, worked the land. They grew corn, winter wheat and soybeans.

When Phil was still in early school, the family moved to a suburban area of Indianapolis, to a town called Speedway City. Anyone who is familiar with the Indianapolis 500 races might recognize that name. From his home, Phil could actually hear the roar of racing vehicles during races; in those days, the racing was limited to one a year, but there was activity present year-round, so it doesn't take much imagination to realize what an exciting attraction race cars would have for a young boy.

Phil had two older brothers; all three boys were enthusiastic sportsmen. Baseball, basket-ball, and football were just three of the high school sports in which they excelled. He also had a sister, who sadly passed away at an early age due to illness.

After high school and college graduation, Phil entered the working world to become a pharmaceutical salesman in the San Francisco area. Unfortunately the company headquarters was completely destroyed during the Northridge earthquake, so Phil moved onward and upward, and took a position with the Grainger Company, a manufacturer of machines and machine parts.

Phil was a single father with three children for a dozen years, well before he and Mary met and married. He focused his efforts on raising his children (similar to circumstances experienced by many single mothers), earned a living, and gave the children a stable, happy home environment in order to start off their adult years. The children flourished under Phil's careful nurturing, and he laughed when he mentioned his children proudly presenting him with his very first "Mother's Day" card. When he got the card, he realized just how much he was appreciated by his kids!

Thirty-plus years ago, Phil met Mary, a single lady with two children, and fell in love. With his three children and her two, they tied the knot and blended their family; a wonderful love story! Mary is a native Floridian, and with Phil having lived in Florida off and on for about 50 years, the Houpts make a great southern couple.

Now in his retirement years, Phil hasn't slowed down too much. He, with Mary's assistance, recharged the Euchre Club with his enthusiastic leadership. Euchre is a game that was a part of his family upbringing which filled many happy evening hours.

Both Phil and his wife volunteer at Mease Countryside Hospital on a regular basis; Phil drives a Care Lift vehicle and Mary acts as his aide, a requirement for all drivers. All in all, Phil has spent about eight (8) years as a hospital volunteer.

Phil is an valuable asset to our community and typifies the kind of person who adds to the pleasure of living in Briar Creek. We salute Phil Houpt, our very first "In the Spotlight" celebrity!



Reminders

Tree trimming reminder: It is each owner's responsibility to be sure any trees over-hanging the roads are trimmed to a height of 15 feet. Keep in mind, when it rains, the branches hang very low, therefore needing the 15 foot clearance. The FIRE TRUCKS AND GARBAGE TRUCKS require this clearance as well as other tall vehicles. Please check your trees!!!! Thank you.

REMINDER TO PET OWNERS

It has been noted that some pet owners have not been picking up after their pet. Please be advised that it is your responsibility to clean up after your pet. Also, do not walk your pet in the non-pet section. Other regulations are included in your documents...please review them.

SPEED LIMIT

Remember, the speed limit in Phase II is 15 miles per hour, yes this means YOU, GUESTS, VISITORS. This is a serious issue and needs all our attention. New Speed Limit signs are being installed to remind us all. Also, a new stop sign at the corner of Cottagewood and BC Blvd has been installed.

REMINDER

DO NOT do any work until the form is approved by the Board and you receive a letter stating the approval. Give yourself enough time for the project as it has to be brought before the Board at the next Board Meeting. Between May and August, there are no Board Meetings, however, the procedure is the same - complete the form and submit to President - four(4) Board Members have to sign off on the form before any work is to begin. Again, give yourself enough time for the change as four(4) members may not be readily available. Once you receive the letter of approval, you may start the work.

Also, be advised, any work requiring a permit from the City/County will not be approved until the permit is attached to the Alteration/Renovation Form. For example, removing trees, pouring concrete to widen driveways or make walkways.


