MESSAGE FROM THE PINELLAS COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT

recently learned that an ATM skimmer was likely installed this weekend on an exterior ATM in the East Lake Road area. These devices unfortunately appear on ATMs (usually on nights and/or weekends) and collect debit card information while customers are withdrawing funds. The collected information is then used to create a "clone" of the customers card and the criminal can now withdraw money or make purchases using the cloned card.

Please be alert and look for anything that seems out of place. These skimmers are created especially for ATMs and are molded and colored the same as the actual machine. In addition, the criminal needs the PIN number to complete the cloned card. These numbers are collected using fake keyboards that lay over the existing keyboard and record the PIN numbers entered. Sometimes a tiny camera is used instead of a false keypad. These cameras are placed above or next to (hidden in a card holder) but in sight of the key pad. Again, the purpose is to record the PIN numbers entered during each transaction.

Please be cautious especially using outside ATMs, although sometimes inside ATMs have been compromised. I suggest avoiding temporary ATMs that have been set up for special events since the security of such devices many times can't be validated. Also, it can be helpful to cover as much of the keypad with one hand while entering numbers with the other, even if no one is around.

I also recommend that debit cards be used as "credit" when making a purchases. If the card information is obtained by hackers, the card cannot be used as a debit (which would immediately drain your checking account) but instead as a fraudulent credit card purchase. This gives you up to 30 days to realize the problem and protects your checking account.

HOUSEHOLD HINTS

¬ asy Peel Boiled Eggs: Use a tablespoon of Baking Soda in your water and the shell
 → comes off in two pieces.

<u>STAINS</u>

- ARMPIT STAINS: 1 Tsp Dawn Dishwashing Liquid (Blue original) 1-2 Tsp Baking Soda 2-3 Tsp Peroxide Apply to stain with toothbrush and work it in to the stain. Let sit for a few hours and then wash as usual.
- BLOOD STAINS: Soak the stained item in COLD water, then apply equal amount of ammonia and water directly on the stain and let it sit. Wash.
- INK: Massage aerosol hairspray to ink stain and then run under cold water. Repeat until gone.
- ANTIPERSPIRANT STAINS: 1/2 Tsp Dawn dishwashing liquid (blue original), plus several drops of vinegar in 1/2 cup of water. Apply to stain with a rag and let sit for a few minutes, rinse with water and blot dry.
- GUM: Freeze the gum by applying ICE and then the gum will break off in pieces.
- Keep in mind you should always do a test area of your clothing before trying the above hints on the entire garment. The above suggestions are no guarantee that all stains will be removed.

What does the term"WHITEWASH" mean?

here are three simple definitions of the word "whitewash":

1. a white liquid mixture used for making surfaces (such as walls or fences) whiter

2. a planned effort to hide a dishonest, immoral, or illegal act or situation

3. a defeat in a game or contest in which the loser does not score any points

Sometimes you'll hear people referring to "whitewash" as simply painting something with white paint, but in the most traditional sense of the term, whitewash is powdered lime (*lime as in limestone*) mixed with water.

Whitewashing has been a favorite paint/sealant in farms and homesteads for centuries because it is effective, simple, and cheap. It's also safe for animals, and you don't have to worry about paint fumes.

It's important to pay attention to what type of lime you are using in your whitewash-be sure to select hydrated lime (also called mason's lime)- NOT dolomite lime or garden lime. Local

building supply stores normally carry lime. Once lime is hydrated (or mixed with water), it's termed "slaked lime."

Whitewash is the perfect coating if you want a bit of old-fashioned charm, but it also has some practical applications too. The main reason it's commonly used to whitewash chicken coops is to brighten the dingy, dark wood. Whitewash also has some antibacterial properties, which makes it a handy option for sealing tough-to-clean surfaces against bacteria and insects.

The biggest downfall to whitewash is that it is water-soluble, so it has to be reapplied every so often. It's not a great option for surfaces that are going to be exposed to the elements, so stick to whitewashing indoor walls/surfaces only.

Whitewash Paint Recipe (provided by Nick Maschak)

7-1/2 lb. unslaked lime

1-1/2 lbs. rock salt

3/4 lb. cement

Dissolve salt in one gallon of cold water; then pour this solution on the lime. Next, add 1-1/2 gallons of water to the lime slowly allowing it to slake. Finally, sprinkle on the cement; slowly, a little at a time and stir thoroughly.

Be sure to apply wash while it is hot. It takes about two days to harden, but will withstand rain, hail, and washing.

Now you know why it's called whitewash!




