These plants grow best when cut back to about three to four feet high or less. Anything over that and they will get leggy.

Our properties (most) are thirty plus years old and taking care of torn screens, or growth or debris on your roof will keep it in good condition. A few owners had to replace their roofs over the summer and the expense is quite hefty. So if you can avoid this by keeping the roof clear of debris to prevent damage, it could be a money-saver.

Our inspections will not begin until 2015; however, if you work on your property a little bit each month, it will keep looking pristine throughout the season. Remember, we're here to help you. If you have any questions, just call us. Looking forward to another successful inspection season.
