FROM THE PRESIDENT'S DESK

It is fun going through the community this time of the year. Residents seem to be at their best with the wonderful weather with plenty of sunshine. For most of us who can't claim to be a real "Floridians" moved here for just this time of the year where we don't have to battle wind, snow, sleet and below zero temperatures. Just this week it was reported that only two states were snow free, and that is Hawaii and of course Florida.

Did you know? We have one of the most state of the art recycling facilities in the nation is right here in Pinellas County, also that it located in a park like setting and offers educational tours to witness what happens to your recycle trash after it leaves the curb. 

REMINDER – PET RULES

s a reminder, according to the Caribbean Isles Rules & Regulations, Pet Rules are spelled out in Section IX, Pets 3 (k) and (l). Please be mindful to pick up after your pets and walk only in the dog walk area specified (copies a reavailable in the Clubhouse). The rules state as follows:

IX. <u>PETS</u> 3.

- (k) Pets may only be walked in the areas shown on the diagram posted in the Management Office. When walking to or from the pet walking area, pets may only be walked on the streets, not on a neighbor's lawn. When walking the pet, the Resident must have with them at all times a suitable means to pick up and dispose of all pet litter immediately. Pet litter must not be buried or covered over, but must be put in a suitable closed container and placed in the garbage for trash collection. It is the owner's responsibility to maintain their unit free and clear of pet litter at all times.
 - (l) Pet owners must comply with all applicable state, county, and local laws. THANK YOU.




