DID'JA KNOW??

roundhog Day always falls on February 2nd, the midpoint between the winter solstice and spring equinox. According to legend, if a groundhog sees his shadow on this day, there will be 6 more weeks of winter.

The tradition stems from farmers who needed to determine when to plant their crops. So, they tried to forecast whether there would be an early spring or a lingering winter. It was not held as a good omen if the day was bright and sunny. If it was cloudy and dark, warmth and rain would thaw out the fields and have them ready for planting.

For centuries, farmers in France and England looked to a bear; in Germany, they kept their eyes on the badger. In the 1800's German immigrants to Pennsylvania brought the tradition with them. Finding no badgers there, they adopted the groundhog to fit the lore. Pennsylvania's Punxsutawney (name of the town) Phil has announced spring's arrival since 1887. Other groundhogs also have carried on the tradition, including Ontario's Wiarton Willie.
