S IT PERMITTED? That's an interesting question that involves two different authorities, Clearwater Cascade Homeowners' Association and the City of Pinellas Park. CCHOA has a number of rules about what may or may not be done to your residence without approval and they are contained in the Rules and Regulations. The City of Pinellas Park also has many rules about what may be done, without a permit, and a much longer list outlining what jobs require a permit. Repairs that might be considered easy, do-it-yourself jobs in Northern New York require a permit here in Pinellas Park. Getting a permit also generally requires a licensed contractor be involved to perform the work. No income tax means the state must find other sources of income and licensure and permits are two ways.

If you are interested in what jobs require a permit, go to www.pinellas-park.com/

617/Permit-Needs. For a much shorter list, look at <u>www.pinellas-park.com/619/No Permit-Required</u>. That's a list of jobs that don't require permits. It's always good to know what you're getting into.

<u>Access Control System</u> – Our new Access Control System is fully active and we have begun creating the new ID Key Badges. Residents should call the office 727-544-8111 to make an appointment to have their picture taken and obtain their ID Key Badge.

<u>Storage Compound</u> – The effective date for the Storage Compound's monthly fee increase has been extended until August 1st.

<u>Hurricane Season</u> - Hurricane Season has begun and will continue through November 30th. As a reminder, all mobile home residents are required to evacuate. Emergency services will not respond to calls when wind speed reaches 35 mph. Now is the time to stock up on essential supplies.

- Although the manager works for the board, she is available to residents. That doesn't mean the manager will drop everything to take your call. If you need to see the manager, call and arrange a meeting and be sure to wear a mask if you visit the office.
- The manager is always happy to answer questions, but she is not the information officer. For routine inquiries, like the date of the next meeting, please read the newsletter, check the association website, One Source or the bulletin boards.
- The manager is responsible for monitoring contractors' performance, but not supervising them. Contractors are responsible for supervising their own personnel. If you have a problem with a contractor, notify the manager, who will forward your concerns to the board and the board will decide how to proceed under the terms of the contract.
- The manager inspects the community from time to time, but even an experienced manager won't catch everything. Your help is essential. If you know about a potential maintenance issue, report it to the office.
- The manager does not set policy. If you disagree with a policy or rule, you'll get better results sending a letter or e-mail to the board than arguing with the manager. We hope this clarifies the role of our manager.

With the rise of the business class in the 19th century, demand grew for neckwear that was durable, comfortable, and easy to tie.



In 1926, a New York tie maker named Jesse Langsdorf developed a technique that improved the tie's elasticity, which allowed it to revert more easily to its original shape. The "Langsdorf" became the most popular form of necktie.

Since then, ties have widened as far as 4.5 inches and thinned to three inches (or skinnier) depending on the current style, but they seem to be here to stay.


