From The Office

WELCOME IRIS ROBINSON!

Iris is our new Admin Assistant in the office. Vanessah Lualhati, before returning to California, has been training Iris for a month. We ask that you are patient with us while she continues the learning process. She has extensive experience and will be a great addition to our staff at Clearwater Cascade.

Iris emigrated from Panama to Miami in 2005 where she lived for eight years, learning English while working in the U.S. All of her family are still in her native country. She moved to our area four years ago and settled in Gulfport because she likes to be near the beach. She has her real estate license that she keeps current and loves to play pool.

GUESTS/VISITORS

Guests are defined as a person who is here to be with you for the day, not overnight.

Visitors are defined as someone "invited to stay with a resident for up to 31 days per calendar year."

Whether you have a day guest or an overnight visitor for a few days and they are going to use the pool, you need to register them at the office and get guest passes for them. If your visitors are staying in your home without you, you will need to notify the office in writing that they will be arriving. This is to protect the owners so that we are aware of who is staying in your home. As written in the rules, they can be here two nights without registering them but if they are using any of the amenities, they need to be registered and have a guest pass regardless of length of stay. Guest passes are not to be given permanently to someone local to take home with them so that they can utilize our facilities at their whim (this has been happening). Our facilities are meant to be used for visiting guests (preferably with the resident). Did you know that the passes are different colors for each month? We now have placed labels on the back of all our guest passes so that it is clear which month that particular pass is intended. We have had a number of instances where outsiders have been caught in our spa and pools, with and without passes. Please assist us in keeping our amenities safe and secure for just residents and their registered visitors.

HANDICAPPED PARKING

We ask that you only use the handicapped parking spots if you have a handicapped license plate or a registered handicapped tag. Please have the tag showing on your rearview mirror or on your golf cart when using the space. We appreciate the consideration for those who truly need those spots.

have read interviews on occasion where the interviewer will ask the question – if you could meet anyone at all – living or dead – who would you choose. Well, I think I would have to add the name Joe Zurla to my list. He sounds like an incredible fellow with a wicked sense of humor and an unending sense of community.

Here's what I have discovered about Joe.

- He had two children, Denise and Joe Jr. (Bud) and six grandchildren, all of whom reside in New Jersey, where Joe was originally from.
- He came to our Park in the early 1980's and resided here until he passed in 2012 at the age of 89.
- He was the most special friend of our Bonnie Keck for 20 years and in fact they both sold their single units and bought a double wide in the last few years of Joe's life so that Bonnie could provide the help Joe needed in those last few years.

This man was a whirlwind of accomplishments! His contributions to the Park include:

• He was responsible for getting wind screening around the pool and until his health issues he was the one who put up the screening in the fall and washed it and took it down in the spring.

• He was responsible for the installation of our bocce court. Joe had to collect signatures of residents who would use the court to accomplish this. He was also the one who set up the

bocce league and took care of it until ill health prevailed.

In both of these cases he had to convince the owner (before we were resident owned) to accomplish these goals. Must have been a smooth talker!

• When he was told that the only thing wrong with our Park were the metal chairs in the clubhouse – he decided to start a pancake breakfast on the 2nd Saturday of every month with the profits going toward the purchase of new chairs. Once he had bought all the chairs he continued the breakfasts and started saving for other things like new chairs for the pool area.



- He organized a neighborhood watch program with Park residents patrolling the park at night in their own cars along with the Park patrol.
 He was also a quite a social butterfly.
- He stepped in to help with the Christmas Bazaar one year and at the completion he bought a gift for each lady that had helped. What a gentleman!
- After the Thanksgiving dinner each year Joe would save the turkey bones and in January he would make turkey soup and hold a Soup and Sandwich night in the clubhouse. It was always well attended.
- He started a Spaghetti night in the clubhouse
- At the annual Christmas Party he orchestrated a twelve days of Christmas routine with all the people in the clubhouse divided into groups and participating. I've heard it was the most fun!
- He served as President of the Golf Club for several years.
- He served as President of the Social Club for a couple of years.
- He organized the Horse Race event held at the clubhouse each year.

One small plaque – one very big man! Here's to You Joe!




