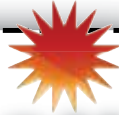

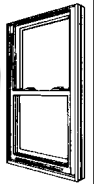

STORM WARNING

Mark Twain once said: “Everybody talks about the weather, but nobody does anything about it.” We can’t do anything about the weather, but there are precautions we can take to protect ourselves and our belongings during storms.

Monitor the storm by keeping a battery powered radio tuned to a weather channel. Before the storm hits, bring in lightweight patio furniture and other outdoor objects that could be thrown around by high winds. Also, unplug expensive electronic equipment, such as your computer or television. If the storm damage does your property, renter’s insurance can help you recover the loss.

If you do not have renter’s insurance, we advise that you look into getting a policy since management is not responsible for your belongings. Contact your insurance agent as soon as possible for more information on how to recover after a storm.

When is hurricane season? The Atlantic hurricane season runs from June 1 to November 30 with the peak period from early August through the end of October. The Atlantic basin includes the entire Atlantic Ocean, Caribbean Sea and Gulf of Mexico. Hurricanes coming from the Atlantic can impact vacations on the Southeast coast, all of Florida, and along the Gulf Coast from the Florida Panhandle to Texas.

What’s typical? Based on historical weather records dating back to 1950, a typical year will bring 12 tropical storms with sustained winds of 39 mph, of which six turn into hurricanes with winds reaching 74 mph or greater, and three major hurricanes category 3 or higher with sustained winds of at least 111 mph.

Should we focus on the number of storms? Yes and no. The only storms most of us need to worry about are those that actually make landfall, which can have little correlation to the total number of storms in any given season. For example, 2010 was an extremely busy season, with 19 named storms and 12 hurricanes; yet no hurricane, and only one tropical storm, made landfall in the US that year.

What do experts say about hurricane season 2015? Most major forecasting agencies will make their predictions for 2015 in the spring. Last year’s predictions were generally on target.

As most agencies predicted, the 2014 hurricane season was quieter than normal. Only one tropical cyclone made landfall in the United States—Hurricane Arthur, which made landfall in North Carolina in early July—but the year continued an incredible lull in major hurricane landfalls in the United States.

FACTS

- June is the sixth month of the year in the Julian and Gregorian calendars and one of the four months with a length of 30 days. June is the month with the longest daylight hours of the year in the Northern Hemisphere and the shortest daylight hours of the year in the Southern Hemisphere. June in the Northern Hemisphere is the seasonal equivalent to December in the Southern Hemisphere and vice versa. In the Northern hemisphere, the beginning of the meteorological summer is 21 June.
- No months start on the same day of the week of June in common or leap years. This month and May are the only two months to have this property. June ends on the same day of the week as March in all years. In all years, June starts on the same day of the week as February of the following year, in years immediately before common years, June starts the same day of the week as March and November of the following year, in years immediately before leap years, June starts on the same day of the week as August of the following year. In years immediately before common years, June ends on the same day of the week as August and November of the following year and in years immediately before leap years, June ends on the same day of the week as May of the following year. In common years, June starts on the same day of the week as September and December of the previous year while in leap years, June starts on the same day of the week as April and July of the previous year. In common years, June finishes on the same day of the week as September of the previous year while in leap years, June finishes on the same day of the week as April and December of the previous year.

NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH TO PREVENT CRIME

At Crystal Lake, participating in a neighborhood watch to discourage criminals from spending time on our streets is something valuable we all can do – even if you have little to no self defense experience or knowledge.



One of the most important things to remember about criminals is that they never want to be seen by anyone, because if they are ever caught by the police they won't want someone to be able to identify them. When a criminal knows there is a good chance they are being watched, they will be far more likely to move on and look for an easier target.

A neighborhood watch is a program in which all the people who live in one area agree to watch out for each other. So if one of your neighbors notices a suspicious character hanging around your house or a car that keeps driving up and down your block they will notify you and contact the police. Criminals are warned of an active watch by signs that are posted prominently in the area. When they see these clear signals that the people in this community are working together to prevent crime, they will know their chances of being caught are much higher and go somewhere else.

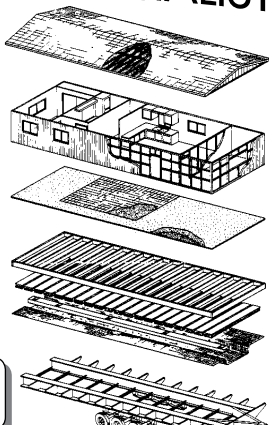

CRIME PREVENTION BEGINS WITH YOU

In Crystal Lake we have a Neighborhood Watch program in which a team of three people patrols the streets of our community. But you can also get involved by watching your neighbors home and surrounding areas. We have our meetings every two/three months to get updates, comments, suggestions, ideas, etc.

We have the support of the Pinellas Park Police Department so every time you see anything/ anyone suspicious; you can call the Emergency or Non-Emergency number. Almost everyone in the community speak English or Spanish but it could be beneficial if there someone to translate to residents who are not bilingual.

IMPORTANT TO REMEMBER

One final thing that is important to remember -- although we are part of a local watch group that helps to prevent crime; we are not trained to stop a criminal. We work as the “eyes and ears” of the Police Department so we are not allowed to take on the job of a law enforcement office. We are working together along with the residents to help deter crime, warn others of potential danger, but never to put ourselves at risk by trying to stop a crime on our own. If any criminal activity is spotted, the best thing to do is to call the police immediately.

DO YOU NEED A RIDE?

- EZride Program – this is a fee for service transportation program offered by Neighborly Care network. The program serves Pinellas county residents aged 55 and older, and disabled residents.

EZride service is offered for ANY trip purpose in Pinellas County with destinations that also include southern Pasco, as well as specific destinations in northern Hillsborough, such as H. Lee Moffitt Cancer center, the VA Hospital/Medical Clinic and the University of South Florida Medical clinics at a flat rate fee.

EZride requires an annual membership fee of just \$25, which can be given as a gift. The cost of each trip is based on a \$3.00 pickup fee plus a charge of \$1.50 per mile for each one-way trip. You can visit the website at www.Neighborly.org or call 727-571-4384. Not too bad for a quick trip to the Dr. or the Grocery store or pharmacy.

- Neighborly Care Network Senior Services Transportation Program is the second option.

This is a door to door service, pick up and drop off for medical appointments. At this time there is NO FEE for adults who are 60 or older or transportation disadvantaged and not on Medicaid.

Medical trips must be within 10 mile radius from pick-up. Vehicles are wheelchair accessible. Clients must register by phone before service begins.

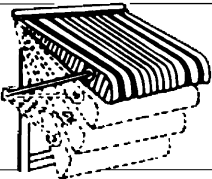

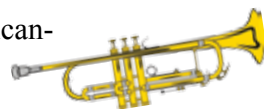

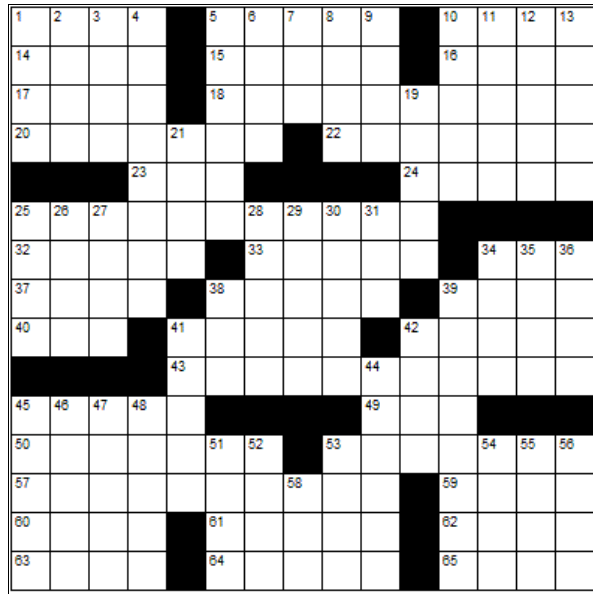
