## FMO: FEDERATION OF MANUFACTURED HOMEOWNERS OF FLORIDA, INC.

OA: The HOA is the local "governing body" of the community. It is a homeowners' association, created under Chapter 723, Florida Statutes, for the specific purpose of either purchasing the community on behalf of the residents and/or representing the community on behalf of disputes between management and the residents.

FMO: The FMO is the statewide organization that lobbies for and defends your rights as a mobile/manufactured homeowner in Florida. We assist in the training, and offer advice, for the HOA officers and directors in a community. The FMO does not assist with or interfere in the governing of the community. That is left up to the community HOA.

FMO needs your help. If FMO is to continue fighting for your rights and protecting your lifestyle, we must keep our membership numbers high. That is what gives FMO clout with legislators and other government officials.

### PARKING ON THE GRASS

ou're house-proud, so you have your friends over all the time. But if you let them park on the lawn (your house, your rules, right?), the vehicles will sink into the yard, compact the soil,



and crush the grass.

Crushed grass becomes dead grass; weeds sprout in the dead spots; and soon your dying, weedy, tire-rutted yard starts chipping away at your house pride (and your home value).

The bottom line is Never Park on the Grass! It's not good for the grass and your vehicle might get towed.

### CRIME PREVENTION TIP

hen writing the date in 2020, write the year in its entirety. It could possibly protect you and prevent legal issues on paperwork. Example: If you just write 1/1/20, one could easily change it to 1/1/2017 (for instance) and now your signature is on an incorrect document.

### **ENERGY SAVING TIP**

djust the direction of your ceiling fan blades to better suit your needs and help save electricity.

A ceiling fan should rotate counterclockwise in the summer so that the blades push cooler air down in a column. The counterclockwise rotation is typically set by pushing the directional switch on the side of the motor housing down, but you may need to check your fan's instruction manual to confirm.

You can turn the fan off when not using the room.



### **RECIPES**

### FRIED IRISH CABBAGE WITH BACON

Ingredients:

- One pound of bacon
- ½ cup bacon drippings
- 1 small head cabbage, cored and finely chopped

### Directions:

- 1. Cook bacon in a deep skillet over medium heat until crisp, 5 to 7 minutes. Remove bacon from skillet and drain on a paper towel-lined plate. Reserve 1/4 cup drippings in skillet.
- 2. Cook and stir cabbage in hot bacon drippings over medium heat until cabbage wilts, 5 to 7 minutes.
- 3. Crumble bacon over cabbage. Stir and simmer until bacon is warmed, 2 to 3 minutes. Season with black pepper.

### Irish Zucchini and Potato Pancakes

Ingredients:

- 1 cup prepared mashed potatoes
- 1 cup all-purpose flour
- 1/4 cup milk
- 1 egg
- 3 Tbs. melted, unsalted butter
- 2 tsp. salt
- 1 ½ cups shredded Yukon Gold potatoes
- 1 cup shredded cheddar cheese
- 1 small zucchini shredded
- Canola oil, as needed

### Directions:

- 1. Stir mashed potatoes, flour, milk, egg, butter and salt in a bowl.
- 2. Add cheddar cheese, shredded potatoes and zucchini until well blended.
- 3. Heat 1 to 1½ Tbsp. oil in a non-stick skillet over medium-high heat.
- 4. Drop batter by Tablespoons into hot oil.
- 5. Cook, turning once until golden brown on each side about 3-4 minutes on each side.
- 6. Repeat with all remaining batter.

### New Earth-like world detected light-years away

he hunt for Earth-like worlds outside our solar system has reached another milestone. The Science Daily website reports that NASA's Transiting Exoplanet Survey Satellite (TESS) has discovered an Earth-size planet in a star's habitable zone, the orbital area where conditions could be right for life.

Although many extrasolar worlds have been found, few the size of Earth have been seen in the "Goldilocks zone"—an orbit that's neither too close to a sun nor too far away, but "just right." The planet, TOI 700 d, is 100 light-years away in the southern constellation of Dorado. It orbits its sun every 37 days and receives 86% of the energy that our sun provides to Earth. It and other planets in the system appear to be tidally locked, meaning as they circle in their orbits, one side is constantly bathed in daylight.

It's the first time TESS has discovered an Earthlike planet. Other such planets have been detected by NASA's Kepler Space Telescope.

Fun fact: The star was initially classified incorrectly in the TESS database as being similar to our sun, which made its planets appear bigger and hotter than they actually are. One of the researchers who identified the error was a high-school student.

### Genetic tweak makes earthworms live longer

e can't make people immortal—yet—but scientists have discovered some genetic tweaks that can extend the lives of earthworms by 500%, according to the Science Alert website.

The earthworms in the study live only two or three weeks, making them good candidates for experiments involving genetic and metabolic processes that they share with humans. Scientists have already discovered that changing the worms' insulin signaling pathway can increase their lifespan 100%. Similarly, alterations to a pathway called TOR (target of rapamycin) results in a 30% extension.

A new study has found that genetically shifting both pathways appears to cause an effect four to five times higher than the single genetic procedure—a synergistic approach that pulls a combination of networks together for the long term.

It's unclear whether the research will ever result in expanded human lifespans, as humans live longer than a few weeks, making experimentation more difficult (and ethically problematical). For now, scientists will have to rely on shorter-lived species like worms, fruit flies, and mice—although in the last year scientists were able to extend the life of mice and reduce their chances of cancer by working with their telomeres.

### **Obesity affects teen brains**

besity is a problem at any age, but a new study suggests it has specific risks for teenagers. As the U.S. News & World Report website explains, advanced MRI techniques show that obese teens tend to have less integrity in the white matter of their brains (white matter contains fibers that connect different parts of the brain). The lower white matter integrity was observed in the region of the brain associated with emotional control and reward seeking.

The study looked at 120 teenagers, and its findings are considered preliminary. Researchers speculate that excess body fat damages the brain through inflammation. The study found a correlation between higher levels of inflammatory substances in the blood and lower white matter integrity. Excess body fat can contribute to inflammation.

The teens whose brains were affected tended to have higher levels of leptin, which is involved in appetite control, in their blood, as well as insulin, which regulates the body's blood sugar.

Doctors point out that obesity has many causes and shouldn't be dismissed as a simple lack of willpower about eating. It's unclear at this point whether obesity is responsible for the change in white matter integrity, or vice versa—or a combination of both.

### **Exercise lowers depression risk**

I f you or someone you know suffers from depression, this news could help. An article on the MedicineNet website reports that 35 minutes of exercise a day could help lower the risk of depression, even among people with a genetic predisposition for it.



Researchers at Massachusetts General Hospital in Boston analyzed two years' worth of medical records and genetic information from close to 8,000 people. They calculated a genetic risk score for each person that predicted the likelihood of depressive episodes. The data showed that people with a higher genetic risk were likely to be diagnosed with depression within two years, but physically active people with the same score—or even a higher one—were less likely to suffer from depression. For every four hours of exercise a week, the risk of depressive episodes decreased by 17%. Both intense, aerobic workouts and low-intensity practices like stretching and yoga showed the same effect.

Getting active may be the key to mental as well as physical well-being.
