We will be getting all of our complaints together in writing to send to whoever we need to send them to. Not leaving out County and State Officials.

Here are SOME of the damages that were found by some of our neighbors. Many which are not our responsibility.

"Fence down in 2 places on the us19 side, tree down on the south side of that entrance, Large bush down on the north side, North side trees haven't been trimmed or the grass mowed all summer on that side as well, looks disgusting driving by on 19. Palm tree leaning on 3rd that may fall into the road, lights broken and in disrepair around the lake, chairs at laundry room missing after the storm and were replaced with broken benches, broken clothes line needs replacing, club house left open during storm when it was supposed to be locked up, screens and roof flashing torn and hanging down from upstairs apartment, broken or unusable locks on the pool gates, large hole in the street in front of #187's driveway, water pooling under the clothes lines due to drainage from air conditioner, hole in the clubhouse ceiling, etc... We should not have to make out work orders for these things, they should be done as a matter of regular maintenance here or taken care of immediately after the storm as they are requesting of us."

"Behind #76 is a huge loose tree stump that could've easily become a projectile in the storm since the tree came down BEFORE Irma. And an empty (park owned) trailer across the street (6th St.) with damage from Irma to the carport."

As you can see I meant what I said. I have no filter and I like it that way. Some things need to be said a certain way so that people can see the real truth behind the words we speak. I say it like it is. I do not tippy toe. One of my favorite sayings is, "If I just offended you, then maybe you need to look at yourself in the mirror and figure out why I would say something so blunt to your face. Your doing something wrong or I wouldn't have brought it up.

The truth hurts, but the truth will set you free. I can sleep at night. How about you?

There are many more things that I can go on about that the Management had lied about, but I don't have time right now. I have to go clean THEIR YARD!



Scientists search for life on the toughest planets

The think of life as viable only on planets orbiting stars like our sun, but scientists now speculate that it could evolve on worlds circling very different types of stars.

Stars called M dwarfs are the most common stars in our galaxy. Their harsh flares and gravitational grip on their innermost planets could interfere with the formation of liquid water, which is necessary for life. However, astronomers have spotted approximately 200 planets circling M dwarfs, and dozens are in the so-called habitable zone where liquid water could exist and temperatures aren't too extreme for the development of life.



Scientists are studying these strange new worlds in hopes of detecting conditions that might lead to life—although it will probably be very different from any life found on Earth.

Lost and found: Seeking owner of ancient sword

Significant cientists are trying to determine the identity of the owner of a 14th-century sword found in a bog in Poland. The four-foot-long sword, which according to the Fox News website is remarkably well preserved, was discovered by a worker using an excavator to drain a peat bog. The worker donated his find to a local museum.

Museum officials speculate that the sword was lost by a medieval knight, or that perhaps the knight perished in the bog. Researchers are examining an engraving on the sword's hilt that may identify the knight or his family. Meanwhile, archeologists are searching the bog for other artifacts.

- **Acrobats.** These thinkers can go both ways. They think outside of the box, but they're also able to hone their ideas into something practical. Try to be this kind of creator.


Improve your brain with these tips


