NEW SOCIAL CLUB DANCE PROCEDURES IMPLEMENTED IN MARCH

t our January Social Club Meeting, the following procedures were adopted with a unanimous vote. It is very important that we implement and follow these new procedures because it will make our dances and special events run much smoother and will be a tremendous help to Donna Gorneault, our Dance Hostess.

NEW YEAR'S EVE:

- 1. Total guests in CH will not exceed 165.
- 2. ALL NON-DORAL RESIDENTS will be charged \$10 more per ticket.
- 3. Ticket prices for Doral residents will not exceed \$25 until it is necessary for yearly increases.
- 4. Cut off sign up and payment dates will be enforced and a wait list will be used if necessary.
- 5. Groups outside of Doral will not be accepted until all Doral residents have been given a chance to purchase tickets.

MONTHLY DANCES:

- 1. Cost of tickets are \$7 if purchased by Thursday before dance and \$10 after that date. Guests who pay at the door will be \$10.
- 2. There will not be any more dance sign-up sheets in the Clubhouse; find full dance details posted in the CH hallway, the Doral Dispatch, and WOW 801.
- 3. Purchase Tickets at Coffee Hour, plus two other designated days, times, and place each week.
 - If purchasing group tickets, please provide first/last names of ticket holders.
- 4. Table seating preferences are secured only at ticket purchase time.





# Manager's Corner - Feb. 2019

Jeff Hahn, LCAM, Property Manager

• Just a reminder of one Rules and Regulations for the Doral Community. First of all, Article IV, Section 1 of your Governing Documents states in part the following:

- o Members and Tenant/Homeowners must obtain written approval from the Board before making any material changes to the outside of their mobile home
- If this rule is not followed, and something was constructed, the structure may need to be removed, and this will be done at the owner's expense. So whenever you are looking to do anything on the exterior of your home, first complete a Request Form to avoid any future issue. These forms are in the Doral Office.
- Please be aware that there is a stop sign at the back exit at Spanish Vista Drive leading to Belcher Road. It has been noted that many people seem to be ignoring that this is there and just speeding in and out of Doral. Please be careful
- I have recently been questioned about dogs living in the non-pet section of Doral. This is a very short synopsis and comparison between what is construed as a Service Animal, and what is considered an Emotional Support Animal. First, A Service Animal is defined as a dog that is trained to do work or perform tasks for people with disabilities. The tasks that a service dog may perform include such things as guiding a person who is visibly impaired and alerting a person who is having a seizure. These are just a couple of the tasks that a Service Dog provides. Service animals are governed under the American with Disabilities Act.

An **Emotional Support Animal** is normally a dog or a cat that provides a therapeutic benefit to its owner through companionship. This animal is not specifically trained and an emotional support animal is not granted access to places of public accommodation. Under the Federal Fair Housing Act (FHA) an emotional support animal is viewed as a reasonable accommodation in a housing unit that has a "no pet" rule for its residents. The Federal Government is now addressing some of the issues that have cropped up because of this allowance, and some new restrictions are being considered.

There is a great deal more information about both Service and Emotional Support Animals than what I can provide in this very short summary. Just go on line and put in these subjects and you will get a wealth of information.




