

Manager's Corner June, 2018 Jeff Hahn, LCAM

- As presented in last month's media, water valves in the park are being identified and in many cases changed. The purpose is twofold, first to replace the valves before they are completely inoperative, and secondly, to enable the Park to shut off the water in certain sections of the community when there is a need to do so. This is a major change from having to shut off the water to most and in sometimes all the homes at Doral for what amounts to a very isolated water issue. With these updates going on, your patience and understanding is very necessary and appreciated, as there may be shut offs that may occur with very little if any notification to you. If you are not getting any water at any time, your first step is to turn your TV to channel 801 to see if there is information regarding your water problem. If it is due to what the Park is doing, it will be presented there. And please keep in mind, what for the most part, Dale Karpp and Richard Gimbert are doing is a long term resolution to an issue that has needed addressed for a very long time.
- By the time you get this edition of the Monthly Media, there may be a very distinctive color change in both the exterior porch and the interior of the cottage. Thanks to the suggestions/ recommendations by Linda Aguinaga and the actual painting by Max, the front entrance will be white to match the rest of the building, and the interior will be a much lighter taupe/ beige look with the baseboard changing from its current brown to a white. Thank you again Linda for your participation in making this alteration happen.
- Just a reminder to everyone...any requests for any changes in the exterior of your home other that your flowerbed, any complaints you may have and any request for assistance you may need must be approved through the Park Office and possibly through the RO Board of Directors. 


