Manager's Corner - March. 2019

- For those of you who are not aware, the RO Association Annual Meeting and Election was held on Monday, February 4th in the Clubhouse. There were five (5) very qualified candidates who were vying for three (3) open two (2) year term positions. As a result of the votes, the Board of Directors stayed the same, as Stephen Oakley, Dale Karpp and Barb Dowds were all reelected to two (2) year terms. After the election, an Organization meeting was held to determine who the Officers of the Board would be. This too did not change, as Steve Oakley was voted in as President, Marshall Hunter as Vice-President, Janice Boorse as Treasurer and David Hatch as Secretary. The three (3) Directors are Barb Dowds, Dale Karpp and David Sweet. Congratulations to all and thanks to all those who cast a ballot and who attended this very important meeting!
- We have come across a number of people in the park who have not registered as guests, some of whom are subletting a residence for an extended period of time. Keep in mind that ALL guests who are here for any period of time are to register at the Office. Also, if there is an automobile involved, parked on the street or in a Guest spot anywhere in the community and there is no Visitor Parking Permit with it, the parked vehicle may be towed.
- Concrete has been poured in the eight or so sidewalk areas that had been left unfilled. Thanks to everyone who was inconvenienced by this longstanding issue for their patience and understanding.
- The new way of now getting a gate sticker for your car or golf cart is to contact the Business office and we will set a time for you to come in to get your sticker. Please keep in mind that we need to see your car registration and driver's license before this procedure can be completed.
- Staying on the subject of the gate, if a visitor is attempting to get into the Park and contacts you, this contact must be made by the visitor using the Informational key pad in front of the gate. There have been instances where people have called a resident and the resident answered their phone, hit #9 as they are to do, but the gate did not open. In large part, this was due to a visitor attempting to gain access by calling on their own cell phone. This does not work, so make certain anyone coming to visit you uses the keypad at the island in front of the gate. And one more reminder, a visitor cannot leave via the gate but must exit to Belcher Road.

KNOW YOUR NEIGHBOR

Interviews by Julie Green # 564

John and Marie Schlesak, #115

Tohn was born in 1926 in what was then Yugoslavia. His parents were both born in Hungary and yet both John and his parents were born in the same town.

It's all a bit confusing but to explain, Yugoslavia came into existence after WW1 and was formed by an amalgamation of Serbia, Croatia, Bosnia, Slovenia, Macedonia and Montenegro. In all this, the part of Hungary John's parents were born in, also became Yugoslavia.

John completed his schooling at just 12 years old in 1938. The language he was schooled in was Yugoslav, however 99% of the townspeople spoke German.

On April 6, 1941, the Germans and their allies Italy and Hungary invaded Yugoslavia and 10 days after that the country surrendered.

A large proportion of the Yugoslavian population refused to fight and viewed the Germans as liberators, freeing them from Government Oppression.

The Germans split the country and Croatia became a Nazi Satellite. Between 1941 and 1945, the Germans murdered 500,000 Croatian people, expelled 250,000 and forced another 200,000 to convert to Catholicism.

When John was just 15, he and 3 other boys and 3 girls walked overland to Croatia to join the German war effort. The German propaganda at this time convinced their youth that joining the war effort was a patriotic thing to do.

However, they were too young to join. Instead, the Germans transported them to a work farm in Thuringia, Germany. This farm grew fruit and vegetables for the local Sanatorium. This hospital treated patients with TB and other lung diseases.

These young teenagers had to keep the sanatorium clean, dig graves and put flowers on the coffins in the viewing room, as well as growing and harvesting the produce they planted.

In 1944 as the war was drawing to an end John was drafted by the German Army into the SS. He was sent to a boot camp in Stralsund, near the northern coast. He arrived in the boot camp just before Christmas. The war ended on May 5, 1945.

His company, in an effort to escape the advancing Russian Army, wanted to be captured by the Allies, and the Americans, and become their POWS.

The company marched all night, hid and slept all day in order to reach the Allied armies. The Americans and Allies were bombing constantly and these teenage soldiers saw things no one should see. They witnessed people being machine-gunned and many other atrocities.

Eventually the Americans captured them. John spent five months as a soldier, never in battle; then 11 months as a POW. He wasn't 18 yet..

John's father was also serving in the German Army and was fighting in Africa. He was captured and served the rest of the War as a POW in England. The Russians arrived in Yugoslavia during the last 18 months of the war. They captured John's mother and sister; they spent the rest of the war in a concentration camp in Yugoslavia. John's brother, also captured by the Russians, imprisoned him in a work camp in Yugoslavia, too.

When the Russians invaded and captured Yugoslavia, they imprisoned most all the population. His grandfather, age 70, was considered too old and was left in his home.

Once John was captured and serving as a POW the Americans arrived and called over a loudspeaker for any soldiers who didn't have any discharge papers. John never had any identity papers; he didn't realize he needed them. He had travelled all over never once having any papers to say who he was. After his release from being a POW in 1946, and his identity checked, he obtained his papers. As a POW John, and the other prisoners, worked at the BMW camp washing and cleaning US rifles; they were then crated and sold to Poland and Czechoslovakia.

After being released from the POW camp, John worked for the city of Munich that was destroyed by allied bombing. He and other locals helped clearing the debris and saw the city slowly rebuilt into the beautiful city it is today. He worked planting trees and then as a gravedigger because that paid more money. All graves in those days were dug by hand.

In 1948, John married his first wife, a farmer's daughter. They had to marry before Lent. The country was still on food rations, so the wedding feast was a slaughtered calf. Both John and his wife worked on the farm and at the local restaurant.

In 1970, John and his wife divorced. He then met Marie, the daughter of the local hardware shop owner.

Marie was born in Chicago in 1938; her father was born in Germany and his father in Hungary. Her mother was born in Chicago. John and Marie married in 1970 and had one daughter together, Lillian born in 1973.

Marie graduated from High School in Jan 1957. She worked part time for her father in the hardware store, and she also worked full time as a pricing clerk for Inland Steel for 16 years. When Lillian was born, she retired to be a full time mum.

John and Marie lived in a gated community in Davis, Illinois, on Lake Summerset. John's parents lived with them. John always grew his own vegetables. His crops were abundant and he was always canning the excess and kept his family well stocked with homegrown vegetables. (No doubt organic as well.)

In 1995, John and Marie returned to Germany to revisit places he was as a young child and a young man. He took Marie to the cemetery in Munich, where he worked, to see the matured trees he planted just after the war.

In 2003, John and Marie bought their first home in Doral Village #59. Together they renovated their home. They were snowbirds until 2015, when they bought their current new Jacobean home, and became full time residents.

John and Marie have enjoyed many activities in the park including the cycle club, bowling and table tennis.

These days, both their daughters, Lillian and Monika, live nearby in Clearwater; John's one grandson is in Pinellas Park. The other grandson, Monika's other son, Alex, lives with his wife, Tracy, in Illinois. John's son lives in Illinois with his wife. He has two children, Emily in Illinois and Brad in Arizona. His daughter, Christa, lives in California with her husband.

Americans prefer to stay at home

Planning a vacation overseas this year? You're not exactly alone, but you're not in the majority. As reported on the NerdWallet website, a survey by Priority Pass found that only 14 percent of Americans plan to leave the United States for a vacation this year. Forty-five percent said they'd prefer to stay in the U.S.

The survey included 10,000 people in nine countries. Overall, 32 percent of respondents said they expect to go abroad for their holidays. Among other travel-related findings from the survey:

- Americans are least likely to spend a cash gift on travel. If given \$300, U.S. residents are least likely to use it to help pay for a trip. People in the United Kingdom and Mexico are most likely.
- Americans spend more on travel. Although they travel less, Americans have the highest per-person budget for overseas travel.
- Americans don't share. Finally, the survey found that Americans are least likely to share their travel memories on social media, or recommend hotels, airlines, and transportation services than residents of other countries.

We're still looking at our phones on the road

Te all know the dangers of texting while driving—or do we? A survey of drivers in Philadelphia, as reported on the Fox 8 website, found that 75 percent admit to using mobile devices behind the wheel.

They're not all kids, either. Although 91 percent of millennials reported using a smartphone or other device while driving, so did 79 percent of Gen Xers and 64 percent of Baby Boomers. What are they doing? Reading text messages or emails (48 percent), updating or checking social media (23 percent), and recording videos (18 percent). Only 9 percent of drivers in the survey said they use a "Do not disturb" app on their phones while driving.
