#### **KNOW YOUR NEIGHBOR** Interviews by Julie Green # 564

### Bruce Van Hee. #473

ruce was born in Centerline, Michigan in 1940. Centerline is part of Warren, Michigan. The name Van Hee comes from his paternal grandfather who migrated to the USA from Belgium. Bruce never knew him as he died before Bruce was born.

His grandfather owned a large 500-acre farm in Minnesota, which was lost in the Great Depression. Once this happened he moved his family to Detroit to get work. Detroit was the center of automotive manufacturing.

Bruce's father was a Sheriff; he then owned a bar with his best friend and then finally worked at Westinghouse.

His best friend was married to his sister.

By the time WW2 started for USA Bruce's parents were married and had two children, one being Bruce. As his father worked in an essential industry he wasn't sent overseas to war.

Below is an excerpt from Wikipedia.

During World War II the Westinghouse Electric and Manufacturing Company manufactured more than 8,000 different products, while its Research Laboratories made critical breakthroughs in plastics, radar, x-rays, bombsights, and atomic energy. The company's naval engine department in South Philadelphia, already one of the nation's foremost turbine engine builders, designed and built improved power plants for naval vessels. In Pittsburgh, Westinghouse's research laboratories contributed to significant improvements in radar, created gyroscopic stabilization device that improved the accuracy of tank guns, and built the first Americandesigned jet engine.

After war ended, his parents had three more children. Of the five, one brother has passed, two sisters live together in San Antonio, Texas, one-brother lives in Upper Michigan, and Bruce and Sandy live in Washington, Michigan.

Bruce graduated from Centerline High School and went straight into the US navy. As he was only 17 he needed his father's signed permission to join. His father had no choice, if he did not sign, Bruce would have joined the day he turned 18.

Bruce had always wanted to join the navy and be a pilot. Circumstances prevented this so Bruce trained as an Aviation Electrician.

One of the big highlights of his career in the Navy was at the age of 19; he had the opportunity to sit in a fighter jet and had full "turn on" rights. This meant he could turn on the engine but not the rights to take off.

Bruce's base was in Brunswick, Georgia at Central Information Center, now decommissioned.

After serving three years in the Navy, Bruce was discharged the day before his 21st birthday. He then served an extra year as a Navy Reservist. He then applied and received a four-year apprenticeship with Ford Motor Company as a Millwright. A Millwright works in steel construction and fabrication, a highly skilled trade.

Bruce worked for Ford for the next 40 years, ending his career as Millwright Leader in the Fabrication shop for the last 15 years.

By the time he retired Bruce was licensed to drive every piece of heavy machinery owned by Ford.



Bruce first married in 1966 and had two daughters. His wife became ill at just 35 from breast cancer and passed away two years later at only 37. His daughters were just 8 & 12. Bruce became Mr. Mom.

Bruce and Sandy knew each other as neighbors in Armada, Michigan, for many years.

Sandy was divorced and she and Bruce began dating and married in 1989, 30 years ago.

Sandy had three children and along with Bruce's two daughters, they became one big happy family, all getting on well. "Too well" at times according to Sandy.

All five children now have excellent jobs, mostly in the automotive industry with Chrysler doing engineering work.

As soon as Bruce retired, they decided (as do many Doral Residents) that they were not going to endure any more Michigan winters. They rented in Doral Village in 2005 for three months and then bought #445. They worked hard on renovating this home and eventually sold it and moved to their current home, #473. They have wintered in Doral Village for 14 years now.

Bruce is an accomplished and talented woodworker; he has made some beautiful cabinets, moldings, etc. for his home. He loves woodworking.

Bruce has recently had two new hips, which has slightly curbed his dancing days. Not by too much if, you have seen him dancing at Doral functions. He has sung in the Doral Kitchen Band since first moving to our village, he plays shuffleboard and cards and likes riding around on his golf cart.

Sandy, whose profile was in our Doral Newsletter some years ago, drove school buses and had a variety of jobs, including township clerk. Her passion however is horses, in particular quarter horses, and miniature horses. She had a 20-acre horse boarding facility in Metamora, Michigan for many years; the area has beautiful horse farms.

Her facility had an indoor arena and she trained and showed horses for more than 40 years. Sandy showed her horses at the National competitions and she was second reserve champion at The Nationals. While Sandy was away exhibiting her horses, Bruce stayed home, as he was not yet retired. They both feel that they are lucky and have the best of both worlds. They see their children and grandchildren in the summer months and spend the winter months with their friends at Doral.

18 months ago, they sold the farm, luckily to their grandson, so it now stays in the family. Sandy loves to quilt, loves shuffleboard and dancing.

One of Sandy's daughters is a professional long arm quilter. For those who do not know what this is, it is a person who does all the beautiful finishing on quilts. One of Bruce's daughters' works in graphic arts design, and the other has a medical work background.


