

Tancy was born in 1934 in Port Hope, Ontario. Her mother was a schoolteacher and her father owned one of the first IGA supermarkets in Ontario. She has one older brother. Port Hope is an historic town at the mouth of the Ganaraska River, on the north shore of Lake Ontario. It was first settled in 1779 by the Cayuga People who relocated from New York State after the Revolution war. Then in 1793 the population was added to by United Empire Loyalists moving from the newly formed United States. The city is about 68 miles east of Toronto. Today the population of the area is around 20,000 people, obviously a lot less when Nancy and Betty were growing up. I'm fact it was about 8,500. However, these days the population is again shrinking due to an aging population. Nancy and Betty George are sisters in law, Nancy having married Bettys brother Blake. Nancy met Blake locally and became firm friends with his sister. They dated for 5 years and then decided to marry. Betty was the maid of honor at the wedding. The two women have known each other since childhood. They went to the same school, albeit a few years apart and both are trained nurses. Blake originally worked at Mikes parent's funeral home and then trained and worked as an accountant at the Ontario Ministry of Transport and Communications. He retired in 1988. Nancy worked in nursing until retirement age. Once retired Blake decided to follow a second career, one he loved. He started building houses. He built their second home near Sault Ste Marie in upper Ontario. This city lies at the junction of 3 of the Great Lakes, very close to the US/ Canada border. The city was named by the French as a reference to the rapids on the river. Across the St Mary's River in Michigan USA, is a city of the same name. These two cities were once one, however, a treaty after the war of 1812, a border was established which split the city into two. The border is the river. Once the only way to cross this border was by ferry, however in the 1950s an International Bridge was built. They built their home in Thessalon in 1993 and Nancy still lives there, on the North Channel of Lake Huron, near Sault Ste Marie. Nancy and Blake have 2 daughters. Jill and her husband Terry are retired and spend five months each year, renting in Florida, this year in Doral. Jill's older sister Janet and husband Dan try to visit Doral every year, but also love continued on page 36



their winter sports up north. Nancy and Blake bought in Doral Village in 1997 after visiting Betty and Mike. For the first 12 years they were tenant homeowners, in fact for a while Nancy was President of the Tenant Homeowners Association. In 2009 they bought a share. Blake became ill while living in Doral Village in 2012 and was airlifted home to Canada. He survived this illness but unhappily passed away in July 2014. Nancy continues to snowbird and loves many activities, golf, bridge, swimming, walking and many other outdoor activities. She has many friends both in Doral Village and many of the other villages in our area.
