n February 9, 2017 we had the regular monthly meeting of the HOA.

Topics of discussion were:



Rental Agreement: Below is since the meeting.

Since the time of the meeting, we received the contract from ELS with new verbiage and new paragraphs added to it. The committee will be going over it on Thursday, February 16th to discuss the new wording which is not in our favor. We will then decide whether to sign the Agreement for the three years, or to not sign because at this point we are only calculating a savings (over our original letters of September 2016) of approximately \$2.40. We are going to determine if the rest of the contract makes it worth signing. Our unfortunate dilemma is not knowing what the economy will be next year? We will advise all residents of the outcome and no matter what agreement we come to and we the committee feel it is the best..55 taxes added to that. Interior lots should go up just about \$19.11 instead of the \$24+ that your original letter stated. Adjustments should be made to your March rents. If I find this will not happen, I will let you know. This increase will be back dated to January 1st. meetings but will have no voting rights. Anyone who moves in after the signed lease will not be able to attend unless they have been a registered resident for at least two years. The HOA Board will have the final input. This will be tweaked as deemed necessary. Right now we are just trying to get this off the ground. We had a quorum at the meeting and motions were made to have a hand vote on allowing couples/partners, daughter/mother and etc. who move in at the same time (and are both registered and background checked) and only one person is on the title, than the person not on the title and over (40) will be able to attend the meetings but will have no voting rights. Anyone who moves in after the signed lease will not be able to attend unless they have been a registered resident for at least two years. The HOA Board will have the final input. This will be tweaked as deemed necessary. Right now we are just trying to get this off the ground.

We also discussed sexual predators taking up residents unbeknownst to anyone. I receive an email from Pinellas County as soon as one comes into our neighborhood. I then check them out through Pinellas County and give all information to management for them to handle. I called Officer Williams and asked if Largo or Pinellas County check where these people are registering and was told only if were in a park, school or where children live. I am unable to publicly put up their mug shot. So please if you see someone move into an empty home please advise myself or the office.

For all of those who have move in with your spouse/partner or parent on the day of your move in and they are qualified and registered, but their name is not on the title, they will be allowed to attend the HOA meetings, but will not have a voting right. So, please if your unit is a member of the HOA, please see a member of the board so that we may check with the office. If you have someone just move in with you, they must be a qualified and registered for two years prior to being able to attend the meetings. This was motioned and voted (a hand vote) on at the February 12, 2017 meeting since there was a quorum present.

We encourage everyone to please get involved with our community because it is also YOUR community.

Complaints: If anyone has a complaint please make 2 copies of it and when you bring it to the office please have them initial and date your copy so you know exactly when you handed it in. Please advise the board so that we may follow up on it also.

A new HOA Down Yonder Residents page has started and only residents can be accepted. If I am not your friend on Facebook send me a friend request and then I will send an invitation for you to join. It is a page for informational purposes only. I will keep you informed of what is going on and remedies of any problems. This is for all registered residents of the community.





Fresh or frozen? The choice is yours

om may tell you over and over again to eat fruits and vegetables that are fresh, but nutrition experts say that frozen produce isn't necessarily inferior. According to *The New York Times*, most nutrients are surprisingly hardy: Iron, for example, stands up to freezing quite well, and fiber does its job whether it's frozen or fresh.

Scientists at the University of California-Davis analyzed the vitamin content in several different varieties of fresh and frozen produce, including blueberries, broccoli, carrots, spinach, and strawberries. They found no significant differences between fresh and frozen items, and even discovered that frozen broccoli contains more riboflavin—a B

vitamin—than the fresh selection. Similarly, frozen blueberries have more vitamin C than fresh.

Experts recommend looking for produce frozen using the IQF process—individually quick frozen"—for the highest quality.

Watch for these sources of illness while traveling

Traveling has enough hassles—check-in lines, lost luggage, bad airline food—without adding germs to the mix. Be safe by watching out for these common sources of germs and bacteria that can make you sick when you travel (from the CNN website):

• Washroom stall locks. In one test, airport stall locks were found to have an average of 70 colony-forming units (CFUs) per square inch. Use soap and water or a good hand sanitizer after touching them.

• Seatbelt buckles. Clean your hands after buckling up. Airplane belt buckles can have up to 230 CFUs per square inch.

• Lavatory flush buttons. These can get pretty nasty, containing 265 CFUs per square inch (although overhead vents and tray tables have more).

• Drinking fountains. Thirsty? Maybe buy a bottle of water instead. The buttons on airport drinking fountains have been found to hold 1,240 CFUs per square inch.




