#### **Home Owner's Association**

At our last meeting on November 11, 2014 we discussed our meeting with our Community Manager, Debra Gibb and the District Manager, Joe Oxford.

One of the topics was the temperature at the pool this time of year. Corporate has determined that no pool temperatures will go above 82°. There are no Federal or State laws that tell what the temperature should be for seniors. There is only a max of 104° for hot tubs. We will continue to work on this.

Pinetree Street is designated to have the drainage problem repaired during the early part of 2015.

Roads are going to be redone starting in 2015. This will be a three year project beginning with the worst streets which will be selected by the paving company.

The District Manager wants to sponsor a 360 meeting with all residents in the beginning of the year. This will be to introduce a day where a dumpster will be available for everyone to discard all items that they don't want and to encourage residents to clean up their yards and gutters. We are going to try to set it before the Snow Birds leave for the north.

This is different than the January 10, 2015"Haz-To-Go". The "Haz-To-Go" is for all electronics, paints, chemicals and etc.

ELS will have nothing to do with AED due to liability. They are discussing with corporate that if the associations pay for it and only has it available during sanctioned functions it may be possible. The Board is also checking with our insurance company.

Surveillance Cameras are being discussed throughout ELS parks. We will hear more about that later

Discussions were started about changes to the Rules & Regulations. It will consist of residents, Board Members, and ELS personnel. It is a slow process and dates to start this have not been discussed.

Since most of our northern friends left last spring there have been a few changes to our

community. STOP signs have been placed around the park in an effort to slow the traffic. So be mindful when driving and be sure to stop at the new signs. Another new item is that there in now a smoking and non-smoking area at the pool. The smoking area is on the west side of the pool (closest to Social Circle East). Please be consider of our non-smokers and use the correct side of the pool.

Manor House: We all have to remember that when we use the Manor House for any functions, private parties and etc., we also must set things back up the way they were. Also we need to at least look under the tables for any leftover food as we only have someone clean it once a week and if food lies on the floor it could cause critters we don't want to see.

Elections: Elections for the Board of Directors will take place at our January meeting. There is a sign-up sheet in the Library if anyone is interested in running. There will be three (3) seats to be filled. You must be a member in order to vote and it is only one (1) vote per unit. If you are a new resident or a resident that has never joined (or has not joined during the last year) you will need to bring a copy of your title for verification. Only persons on the title will be able to attend the meetings. The dues are \$20 per year. You may call any of the Board members for an application.

SAFETY DATA BASE: This would be your Plan B. We now have over 50 people in the data base that will only be used if you have an emergency. It gives us the information of the person you would want contacted if something should happen to you. This is not for single people only, couples should also participate. The Manager's Office closes on Fridays around 4 p.m. and does not open until Monday morning (if a holiday, Tuesday morning) and therefore there is no way to get the records for your next of kin or your designated person. We would also like everyone to be aware of the activity on your street. Even though you might not know your neighbor, be mindful if something looks amiss. We ask everyone to seriously think about "how will your "person" be contacted if you are not conscious. This data base will be kept with the HOA and is confidential and will not be used in any other way.

Safety—The Board would like everyone to be mindful of people who have been seen lurking in carports, asking for alcohol and prescription drugs. Please report any of this IMMEDIATELY to the office or to a member of the Board. This will not be tolerated. Also, be mindful to anyone going door to door/befriending you and asking about signing up for services that you may not need. If you think you don't completely understand what they want you to sign up for, contact your family member and ask them what they think before you sign. You may be signing your possessions and care away to people who you should not. There are people that go after seniors and you may sign something you don't realize. Please DO NOT open your door for anyone you don't know. There is no SOLICITING in the park! Call the office and let them know immediately.

Volunteers are always welcomed and needed for many aspects of the functions that the organizations have during the year. Anyone interested in giving a helping hand please contact either myself or any board member of the HOA, the Community Association or Ladies Auxiliary.
