






Shuffle Board

- 3. Add butter, rub with fingers until mixture resembles cornmeal, then add sugar and apricots.
- 4. Add egg mixture and knead until well blended.
- 5. Make 10 balls bake on ungreased sheet until slightly brown 12 -15 minutes.




