Te will be selling tickets for pancake breakfast at Koffee Klatch on November 1st. Pancakes will be November 8th.



s we begin our "Season" we would like once again to welcome all of our northern friends back and welcome any new comers for the upcoming year.



functions. Remember the Office closes at 4:00 p.m. on Fridays, so if you need to borrow these items for a weekend you must get them before the office closes. Please look around your unit and if you have forgotten that you had one and please return it to the clubhouse.

Elections: Elections for the Board of Directors will take place at our January meeting. There will be a sign-up sheet in the Library if anyone is interested in running. There will be three (3) seats to be filled. You must be a member in order to vote and it is only one (1) vote per unit. If you are a new resident or a resident that has never joined (or has not joined during the last year) you will need to bring a copy of your title for verification. Only persons on the title will be able to attend the meetings. The dues are \$20 per year. You may call any of the Board members for an application.

SAFETY DATA BASE: This would be your Plan B. We now have over 50 people in the data base that will only be used if you have an emergency. It gives us the information of the person you would want contacted if something should happen to you. This is not for single people only, couples should also participate. The Manager's Office closes on Fridays around 4 p.m. and does not open until Monday morning (if a holiday, Tuesday morning) and therefore there is no way to get the records for your next of kin or your designated person. We would also like everyone to be aware of the activity on your street. Even though you might not know your neighbor, be mindful if something looks amist. We ask everyone to seriously think about "how will your "person" be contacted if you are not conscious. This data base will be kept with the HOA and is confidential and will not be used in any other way

Volunteers are always welcomed and needed for many aspects of the functions that the organizations have during the year. Anyone interested in giving a helping hand please contact either myself or any board member of the HOA, the Community Association or Ladies Auxiliary.

TELEPHONE DIRECTORY – For all the new residents, we urge you to have a number listed in our directory for emergency purposes. This will also help our street captains that will ONLY call you in case of emergency situations in the park (i.e. water shut-offs, electrical shut downs and etc.) Remember they are only disbursing information for you safety and you should not be calling them for any other information about the situation.

NEW RESIDENTS— Again I will remind you we are a community that is governed by a Prospectus which contains the rules and regulations of what is allowed and not allowed, what is expected of the corporation that owns the property and what is expected of us as residents. Please take the time to read your Prospectus and know the rules set forth many years ago. Please remember when you signed your lease assumption you agreed to abide by these rules and regulations. We have all moved here because it is Age Qualified and not a family park. The minimum age is 40. For those who have under minimum age persons who move in, you will be noticed at some point, and reported to management. Please do not blame your neighbor, the



HOA or anyone else, you are the one who made the choice to go against what you had agreed to.

When you have a problem please do not go into the Manager's Office screaming. This unfair to her and her entire staff. This also doesn't settle many things. Please be polite and you will receive the same treatment back.

The next HOA meeting for members will be November 11, 2014 at 7 p.m. in the Manor House. We look forward to everyone returning and joining our community for a season of functions and fun! We also have voting for the Board in January and you must be a member to vote. Three (3) seats will be open for the election. Our November meeting will be an open house for all home owners (no renters).
