If you see a street light out in the community, please contact Duke Energy at 727-443-2641 and select option 1 to report it. On each street light post there is a metal tag that has the ID number on it, you can provide that number or provide the lot numbers the pole is closest too. Thank you!

Down Yonder is governed by the Fair Housing Act and the Americans with Disabilities Act, as well as the prospectus/rules and regulations. If you feel or see something or someone that you think is non compliant with these, please do not approach the individual or situation (this could be considered harassment). If it is an emergency, of course dial 911, otherwise, please complete a resident form and drop it off at the office or to Linda Thoma the HOA president. The office will review the complaint and take action if a resolution is necessary, it will be taken care of. We work very closely with the ELS attorney to make sure we are compliant with the rights, rules and regulations. Thank you for your cooperation and understanding.

On a very serious note, bullying of any resident will not be tolerated. If you have questions regarding a resident please complete a resident form. **DO NOT** approach or yell out comments in passing to any resident regarding age, disabilities, or pets. The Fair Housing Act and the Americans with Disabilities Act is designed to protect the residents. The office uses every tool possible to make sure we are in compliance, including ELS attorneys. Thank you for your cooperation.

All of the lot rent increase letters have been sent. If you did not receive a letter please contact the office ASAP to obtain a copy.

Throughout October we received several calls in the office regarding cars being broken into, please remember to lock your vehicles. As a reminder, ELS does not offer security so please be proactive in protecting YOUR home. Motion lights mounted on your carport or around your home is an inexpensive way to deter unwanted "visitors" from snooping around your home and vehicles.

Lawn care-please understand that there is no set time for your lot to be mowed during mow days. There is no need to call the office if your lawn hasn't been mowed by a "usual" time. There are several different factors that could contribute to the team not mowing your lot by a time you feel is a regular time such as equipment problems or weather. If your lawn was not mowed on a regular mow day, please contact the office the next day to let us know.

Our next meeting is **DECEMBER 8, 2015**, at the Manor House at 7:00 pm. This is an important meeting because we will be going over the pros and cons of items that will be included in the HOA's new Bylaws. Those items are:

- a. Reducing a quorum from 50% + 1 to 30%
- b. Terms of Officers limit of 2 terms
- c. Dues \$10 up to \$25
- d. Number of Directors from 7 to 9
- e. Annual Budget

This is also the last night for floor nominations for the Board of Directors. There are four (4) seats open. Please think about running for the Board. Although many residents are still in the work force we would like to see you on the ballot. Meetings are held from October through April one night a month. 
