If you are going to sell your home, please advise the office of the realtor involved. We have several people that stop in our office asking about homes that we do not have listed. If we know, we can help inform buyers too. We also need to be sure they advertise properly on the websites.

In recent weeks we have been tagging autos that are illegally parked. Some of you have blatantly disregarded these notices. I have had several complaints about this and it takes too much time from my schedule everyday to deal with them. Read your rules & regulations! It clearly states no parking on the streets, grass etc. **These rules are meant for ALL residents, not just the ones who follow them**. If you are parking your second vehicle at the Clubhouse, this will stop. Or it will be towed legally! You have a driveway, put your car there. If you are driving a commercial vehicle, again read the rules & regulations, no commercial vehicles. Tag numbers are being recorded going forward. If this continues, you will be turned over to legal for rules violations and risk getting you vehicle towed at your expense.

I also read the daily update from the Tampa Bay Times and watch CBS News almost nightly, so I keep up-to-date with what's happening in the state and country beyond the information we get through Canadian media. I wouldn't have imagined how attached I would become when we first joined the Eldorado community. How I miss it when I'm not there!

You might be interested to know about the "Trump Bump" that some claim is hitting Cape Breton. In February, a local radio host read news items about people in the USA who said they would leave the country if Trump becomes President. He meant it as a tongue-in-cheek comment, but it received wide media attention, including coverage by CNN, the Washington Post and news outlets in Britain. The site has been accessed over a million times and inquiries to the local tourism agency skyrocketed, necessitating staff increases. It's hard to know exactly why that is happening, but some are saying we should thank the Donald. We're connected, it seems, even when we're thousands of miles apart.



Information about water shutoff's

s most residents know, there are times that the water in Eldorado has to be turned off to make repairs. There is nothing we can do about that, but there are some things that we can do to avoid trouble. We have adopted a new system to notify residents in the event water is turned off. This system will generate a phone call to the residents alerting them to the fact that the water is off or will be shortly. If you have caller ID, the number 599-2066 will show up with the name Eldorado Village. For those who have asked to not be robo-called, a personal call will come. We suggest that you turn off your hot water heater if you are concerned about it. Also, when you want to check if the water has come back on, use the cold water for this purpose so as to not let air into your hot water heater. You can also turn off the water coming into your home, which will prevent water from draining out of your home and into the water system. Some folks keep a few gallons of water on hand just for such emergencies.

PLEASE DO NOT CALL THE OFFICE TO ASK ABOUT THE WATER. SHUTOFF'S

- 2. Please do not place trash into boxes. Boxes must be flattened and tied with string. "all broken glass/mirrors must be placed into a box and taped securely dispass of all modicil poollog and modicines properly do not place in trash base.

dispose of all medical needles and medicines properly do not place in trash bags.

- 3. All newspaper should be bundled and tied securely with string.
- 4. Trees and brush trimmings must be cut into no larger than 4 foot lengths and bundled in no more than an 18 inch diameter, in order to be picked up.
- 5. All weeds, leaves and lawn trimmings must be placed in plastic bags and tied closed for proper pick-up. Bags are to weigh no more than the 25 lbs as specified above.
- 6. Furniture appliances paints and any constructional materials will not be picked up.

- a. Place furniture and constructional debris in open top dumpster.
- b. Appliances and paint please call Pinellas county solid waste division 727-464-7500.
- 7. Please do not place any trash out the night before pickup p. this will invite animals to rip and open your garbage making it more difficult and time consuming for pick-up. Uncontained garbage and fluids are a great health risk if inhaled to your neighbors and to our staff.

Watch for the dangers of carbon monoxide

arbon monoxide (CO) is a colorless and nearly odorless gas created by the incomplete burning of solid, liquid, and gaseous fuels. It's poisonous to people and pets, so be careful. Symptoms of the poisoning are:

- Headache
- Fatigue
- Shortness of breath
- Nausea
- Dizziness

To prevent CO poisoning, take these precautions at work and at home:

- Buy and install a CO alarm. Make sure it meets safety requirements, and follow the directions for proper placement and installation.
- Install appliances properly. Most of them should be installed by a professional.
- Check your appliances. Have your heating system inspected and serviced every year.
- Only burn charcoal outdoors. Never burn it in a tent, home, garage, vehicle, etc.
- Make sure you turn off fuel-burning engine equipment when you are inside a garage or basement. Just having the doors open does not ensure your safety.
- Always follow the manual directions when servicing fuel-burning equipment.
- Do not use gas appliances, such as ranges, ovens or clothes dryers, to heat your home.
- If you use a fuel-burning appliance that is approved for indoors, make sure it is vented to the outside following the manufacturer's instructions.
- Install and use exhaust fans over gas stoves.
- Open flues when you use your fireplace.
- Choose the proper size wood-burning stove for your home.
- Have a professional inspect, clean and tune up your central heating system (furnaces, flues, and chimneys) annually.
