E Idorado Village Homeowners Association had their first meeting Dec. 3rd. If you missed it, I believe you missed a lot of important information. We discussed the new Florida Law 723 that went into effect last July 1st and how it might affect us. We discussed rent negotiations and how that saved you money the last 3 years. Almost every homeowner (with a few exceptions) in the park saved approximately \$40-60 per year for each of the last 3 years, due to the rent negotiations done by your HOA. Can you not take \$10.00 of that and pay your assessment to HOA?

On January 14, 2016 there will be another HOA meeting, as mandated by FS 723, with the express purpose of taking nominations for director from the floor. A full explanation of this new section of the law was given last week. If you have any questions, please see a HOA board member.

This system will generate a phone call to the residents alerting them to the fact that the water is off or will be shortly. If you have caller ID, the number 599-2066 will show up with the name Eldorado Village. For those who have asked to not be robocalled, a personal call will come. 




