Information about water shutoff's

s most residents know, there are times that the water in Eldorado has to be turned off to make repairs. There is nothing we can do about that, but there are some things that we can do to avoid trouble. We have adopted a new system to notify residents in the event water is turned off. This system will generate a phone call to the residents alerting



them to the fact that the water is off or will be shortly. If you have caller ID, the number 599-2066 will show up with the name Eldorado Village. For those who have asked to not be robo-called, a personal call will come. We suggest that you turn off your hot water heater if you are concerned about it. Also, when you want to check if the water has come back on, use the cold water for this purpose so as to not let air into your hot water heater. You can also turn off the water coming into your home, which will prevent water from draining out of your home and into the water system. Some folks keep a few gallons of water on hand just for such

emergencies.

PLEASE DO NOT CALL THE OFFICE TO ASK ABOUT THE WATER. SHUTOFF'S There is nothing they can do, to help you.

Recycling is a way that we can all help to save on our trash bills. The city of Largo charges by weight for garbage and trash, so the more recyclables that we can put into the recycle bin in the "salad bowl" in East Bay Oaks, the more we can save on our trash bills.

The new recycle plan in Largo is great in that we do not have to separate our recyclables. Everything that is recyclable goes into the one bin. This certainly makes it much easier to "do the right thing" and we not only save money for ourselves, but we are helping with the environment as well.

The things we can put in the bin is as follows: Glass (colored bottles and jars) Cartons (milk and juice containers) Mixed Paper (Newspapers, flattened cardboard boxes and office paper) Plastic Containers (food and beverage) Aluminum and Metal (cans and containers).

The things we <u>should not</u> put in are as follows: plastic bags and wrap, Styrofoam containers/ packaging, food waste/household garbage or chemicals/electronics (which includes, paint, light bulbs, batteries, computers etc.)

So fellow residents, please consider all of the above and let's work to help save ourselves a few bucks and at the same time, work toward a greener environment

TRASH PICK-UP SERVICES

- 1. All garbage must be placed into plastic bags and securely tied weighing no more than 25 lbs.
- 2. Please do not place trash into boxes. Boxes must be flattened and tied with string. "all broken glass/mirrors must be placed into a box and taped securely
- dispose of all medical needles and medicines properly do not place in trash bags.
- 3. All newspaper should be bundled and tied securely with string.
- 4. Trees and brush trimmings <u>must</u> be cut into no larger than 4 foot lengths and bundled in no more than an 18 inch diameter, in order to be picked up.
- 5. All weeds, leaves and lawn trimmings must be placed in plastic bags and tied closed for proper pick-up. Bags are to weigh no more than the 25 lbs as specified above.
- 6. Furniture appliances paints and any constructional materials <u>will not</u> be picked up.
- a. Place furniture and constructional debris in open top dumpster.
- b. Appliances and paint please call Pinellas county solid waste division 727-464-7500.
- 7. Please do not place any trash out the night before pickup p. this will invite animals to rip and open your garbage making it more difficult and time consuming for pick-up. Uncontained garbage and fluids are a great health risk if inhaled to your neighbors and to our staff.


