

RECIPE OF THE MONTH

SNICKERDOODLES

Ingredients:

- 1 c. soft Crisco shortening
- 1 ½ c. sugar
- 2 eggs
- 2 tsp cream of tartar
- 1 tsp baking soda
- ½ tsp salt
- 2 ³/₄ c. sifted flour

Directions:

- 1. Cream together Crisco and sugar.
- 2. Add eggs, cream of tartar, baking soda and salt.
- 3. Slowly add the flour and mix well.
- 4. Roll dough into balls the size of small walnuts. Roll in a mixture of 2 Tbsp. sugar and 2 tsp. cinnamon (Red or green Christmas sprinkles can be substituted for the sugar).
- 5. Place 2 inches apart on an ungreased cookie sheet (they puff up and spread while baking).
- 6. Bake at 400 degrees for 8-10 minutes, until lightly browned around the edges.

FROM THE OFFICE:

elcome back to all our returning residents. Please stop by the office and make sure we have current emergency information on file for you......if it has been awhile since you provided this information, chances are good that maybe phone numbers have changed. I also would like to have a copy of the title for your mobile home on file......too often residents have neglected to put them in their name; when they sell or leave for whatever reason, it often takes months to get some titles straightened



out with Florida Department of Motor Vehicles. Also, recently residents encountered a problem when they applied for FEMA funds and could not produce a title in their name....if I had a copy in the office they would have been all set.

A reminder to anyone who has not picked up their phone books, they are available in the office. (They are only available to residents who had their picture taken....no other phone books are available).

Please do not take shortcuts through people's lawns without permission. Also, do not drive golf carts thru the parking lot of the old gym building as a shortcut into the park...I am working with the new owner to get the fence replaced, as required by code, but in the meantime, be a good neighbor and stay off his property.

In respect of your neighbors, please keep the noise down after 10 p.m. I realize that we all have different internal clocks, but living in a 55+ park means the residents have a right to expect "night owls" to be quiet. This sometimes may mean to not blast your TV, often located in a screen room that adjoins the bedroom window side of your neighbor's home.

I am seriously thinking about a strict limit to dogs only in the pet sections moving forward.

A VISIT WITH THE PURTONS




We have officers who are elected every year with some term limits.





Book Recommendation:

Here Vultures Fly

by Rudy Rodrigues

This is the narration of the personal experiences of the author, Rudy Rodrigues, during his ten years of service with the United Nations in Afghanistan, where he was engaged in emergency relief and later rehabilitation programs in close collaboration with the Communist government, the mujahideen, the Taliban, and the post-Taliban government.

The author was responsible for opening the first UNICEF office in Kyrgyzstan soon after the collapse of the Soviet Union in a unique environment and culture. During this time, he was working with a government unfamiliar with the United Nations and its goals and objectives. In addition, the Kyrgyz population was traumatized by this sudden period of transition and uncertainty. A major focus of the author's work was gaining the



confidence of the government in Uzbekistan and to ensure the building of meaningful partnership programs for women and children.

This book also covers the adventures, romance, and thrill of being born and raised in Kenya; serving as an officer in the army; the challenges of working in Papua New Guinea; and having the glorious opportunity of working in the UN in different parts of the world with a multiethnic/multicultural community.

About the Author

Rudy Rodrigues was born and raised in Kenya. He graduated from the Royal Military Academy Sandhurst and the British Army Staff College. He was commissioned and served as an officer in the Kenya Army in both command and staff appointments. Resigning after sixteen years of active service, he then immigrated to Canada with his wife and three children.

Later, Rodrigues was appointed country director of a Canadian NGO in the Sudan, with a mandate to provide leadership, strategic planning and the delivery of UN (WFP) emergency relief supplies to the more than three million starving people displaced by the famine of 1985. He did so using a fleet of 350 cargo vehicles and a staff of over 3,000 people. This trucking operation was later taken over by the UN, and Rodrigues served as its Director.

In 2006 Rodrigues ended his career, and moved from Afghanistan, where he was last working with the United Nations. He retired to Winter Park, Florida where he lives today, and enjoys traveling, writing and spending time with his family, children and grandchildren.
