### RECIPE OF THE MONTH

### **TUNA TOMATO CASSEROLE**

### Ingredients:

- 1 package (12 ounces) wide egg noodles, cooked and drained
- 2 cans (6 ounces each) tuna, drained and flaked
- 1 cup mayonnaise
- 1 onion, finely chopped
- ½ teaspoon salt
- ½ teaspoon black pepper
- 8-10 plum tomatoes, sliced  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch thick
- 1 cup (4 ounces) shredded Cheddar or mozzarella cheese Directions:
- 1. Preheat oven to 375 degrees
- 2. Combine noodles, tuna, mayonnaise, onion, salt and pepper n large bowl; mix well
- 3. Layer half of noodle mixture, half of tomatoes and half of cheese in a 13 x 9 inch baking dish; press down slightly, repeat layers
- 4. Bake 20 minutes or until cheese is melted and casserole is heated through
- 5. Makes 6 serving

### FROM THE OFFICE

Tplan on opening my Office on June 1st. There will be some changes. Due to the uncertainty of Covid-19, these changes will be made:

- L 1. Come in to pay rent ONLY
  - 2. All complaints must go on a form; pick it up and then leave, you can put it in the mail slot when completed
  - 3. I will be seeing people by appointment only, so call ahead
  - 4. If you are sick, stay away!

These changes are necessary because of the size of both of the offices and the continued unknown about Covid-19. Yvette and I will not be wearing masks (our sandbox, our choice)


Once again, people are either selling their mobile without Park approval, or moving in roommates, family, etc. without my approval. Trust me when I say that you have a better chance of them staying for awhile if you are up front with me, than if I have to hunt you down to get answers! NO mobile home can be sold without Park approval, EVEN if they currently live in the Park. If you sell without approval, I can demand that the new person move out until approved....not a good start for a new resident who doesn't know they are in violation of the park rules. There also is a limit of 2 mobiles per person and you may not know if they own 2 already. Some current residents have been approved as "a roommate only" which could mean I have not verified their income (ability to pay rent). The tenant application can be printed from the Park's website, embassyparkflorida.com. It is 2 pages; you also need to submit a copy of their Drivers License, Income verification and a \$100 non refundable processing fee. All guests over 48 hours must be registered in the office. If the office is closed, send an email and I will contact you.

Hurricane season is here; unfortunately, I do not have 2020 Hurricane Guides; to the best of my knowledge they are not printed yet. I will continue to research this. I am sure they will be considerably different from the 2019 guide due to Covid 19 guidelines being put into place. In the meantime, make sure you are stocked up with essentials and have all of your important papers together in case of evacuation (don't forget your meds!). Make sure your yards are hurricane ready.....make sure there is nothing laying around that could become a damaging projectile during hurricane force winds. Also, after any rainfall you should make sure you have no standing water—this breeds mosquitos!

The POOL will remain open at 50% guidelines until further notice from Pinellas County. Please continue to follow the guidelines posted at the Pool. Kids hours remain 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. Many residents are babysitting their grandkids during the day (no rule against it); they have the right to bring them to the pool.

Manager's Meeting for June 10th, 9:00 A.M. for coffee; meeting at 9:30 a.m. Signs will be posted to confirm (or cancel) this meeting based on what the current "safe at home" order is. Please practice social distancing.





### Fun facts about your Father's Day gift

ather's Day is June 20 this year, and the 65 million fathers in the United States (give or take a few million) will bask in familial attention and be showered with gifts—mostly neckties.

The modern necktie evolved from the small, knotted neckerchiefs worn by Croatian mercenaries working for the French in the Thirty Years' War. The word cravat derives from a combination of the French "Croate" and the Croatians' own name for themselves, "Hrvati."

With the rise of the business class in the 19th century, demand grew for neckwear that was durable, comfortable, and easy to tie.



In 1926, a New York tie maker named Jesse Langsdorf developed a technique that improved the tie's elasticity, which allowed it to revert more easily to its original shape. The "Langsdorf" became the most popular form of necktie.

Since then, ties have widened as far as 4.5 inches and thinned to three inches (or skinnier) depending on the current style, but they seem to be here to stay.

### **Coronavirus spurs creative solutions**



he COVID-19 pandemic is scary, but if it has any upside, it's in the way the crisis has sparked innovation and creativity in business.

The BBC website reports that the Washington, D.C., public library hosts a virtual book club for readers, and chef Massimo Bottura of Italy has launched an Instagram series to teach basic recipes to homebound cooks. An art teacher in Tennessee is livestreaming classes for children who want to be creative.



Speaking of art, museums such as the Louvre in Paris have been offering virtual tours, and art lovers can view classic sculptures from the Vatican.

Small-business owners are thinking outside the box and taking steps to address the crisis, the U.S. Chamber of Commerce website reports. Cycling apparel company Kitsbow in North Carolina has shifted from making jerseys to manufacturing personal protective equipment (PPE), and it plans to produce 26,000 face shields and face masks. Similarly, Sweaty Bands, a maker of no-slip headbands for activewear, is repurposing materials into facemasks for local hospitals.

On another front, cosmetics maker Garb2Art has found a new market for a hand sanitizer it developed three years ago. Revamping the production process, the company has expanded its staff from five people to 25 and recouped its \$25,000 investment in bottles and alcohol in a single day.






