

RECIPE OF THE MONTH

Taco Salad Casserole

Ingredients:

- 1 pound ground beef
- 1 cup chopped onion
- 1 can (15 ounces) chili with brans
- 1 can (about 14 ounces) diced tomatoes
- 1 can (4 ounces) diced green chiles, undrained
- 1 package (about 1 ounce) taco seasoning mix
- 1 bag (12 ounces) nacho-flavored tortilla chips, crushed
- 2 cups shredded cheddar cheese
- 2 cups shredded mozzarella cheese
- 3 to 4 cups shredded lettuce
- 1 jar (8 ounces) prepared taco sauce
- ½ cup sour cream

Directions:

- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees F
- 2. Brown beef and onion in large skillet over medium heat, 6 to 8 minutes, stirring to break up meat. Drain fat.
- 3. Add chili with beans, tomatos with juice, chiles and taco seasoning mix; cook and stir until heated through. Place half of crushed tortilla chips in a 2 ½ quart casserole. Pour beef mixture over chips; top with cheddar, mozzarella and remaining chips.
- 4. Bake 30 to 40 minutes or until hot and bubbly. Serve over lettuce; top with taco sauce and sour cream

Tell, the Park is slowly thinning out. Soon we will be having daily summer showers, with the rapid growth of our flowers and lawns. I will be putting the lawn service on a regular schedule for the summer, so please keep your yards clear of hoses, bikes, furniture, etc. It is impossible to say what day it will be because the rains throw off their schedule.

Effective immediately, the Office will only refer service companies that are licensed and insured. If you want to choose one of the people in the Park, that is still your choice. If you live in the park and offer any services, such as weeding, painting, etc. the Bulletin board inside the clubhouse is where park residents post notices. This board is for residents only and the notice must be the size of a 3 x 5 card. Please do not remove someone else's notices.

There will not be any Bulletin published this summer, but there will be a "Bulletin" page in the News and Views. If you have anything you would like printed in it, please email me or write it down and drop it off at the Office. (special announcements, illnesses, deaths, etc.) The deadline is usually by the 15th of the month.

I have received the DBPR approval regarding the amended Prospectus, Lease and Rules and Regulations. As I mentioned at my March meeting, I spent a lot of time fine tuning these items; it paid off because DB

PR rarely approves anything on the first try! Unfortunately, I still need to get with the attorney on proper distribution so I have no further information at this time.

A reminder to notify the Office of your leave and return date; you can do this by stopping in during office hours or sending us an email at embassymhp@hotmail.com. Be sure to include: correct summer address; email address (comes in handy in case of emergency in Park); phone number; if someone in the Park is watching your mobile in your absence, who is taking care of any needed yard work and an approximate date of your return. Remember that if you allow a family member to use your unit in your absence, you must notify the office in advance. I will be evaluating lots by the 1st of September, which is grow season here in Florida (weeds grow better than flowers!). If you plan to return after that date you will definitely need someone to weed regularly or face the possibility of being charged if the Park has to do it for you (all perfectly legal and allowed by the Park Rules and FL Statute 723).

THE NEXT MANAGER'S MEETING WILL BE WEDNESDAY, JUNE 12TH, coffee & cake at 9:00 a.m., meeting at 9:30 a.m. (No meetings will be held in May, July, August unless needed).

A "Certificate of Appreciation" was given to Danny Czapiewski for his role in coaching several new players during the year.


