

RECIPE OF THE MONTH

FARM-STYLE CASSEROLE

Ingredients:

- 1 Tablespoon canola oil
- 1 small onion, chopped
- 1 clove garlic, minced
- 1 pound ground beef
- 1 can (about 14 ounces) diced tomatoes
- 1 cup frozen corn
- 1 cup frozen baby lime beans
- 1 teaspoon salt
- ½ teaspoon dried oregano
- 1/4 teaspoon black pepper
- 2 cups cooked macaroni or other pasta
- 1 cup crushed tortilla chips



Directions:

- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees
- 2. Heat oil in large nonstick skillet over medium heat. Add onion and garlic; cook and stir 5 to 6 minutes or until onion is tender. Add beef; brown 6 to 8 minutes, stirring to break up meat. Drain fat
- 3. Add tomatoes, corn, lima beans, salt, oregano, and pepper; cook and stir over high heat 5 minutes or until all liquid is evaporated. Stir in macaroni. Transfer to 9-inch square baking dish; sprinkle with tortilla chips
- 4. Bake 20 minutes or until heated through.

Makes 4 to 6 servings



Seeing as how it is not "business as usual", I will not be posting 7 day notices; the Park rule violations **that have not been remedied** will be top priority when the office and Courts reopen. I will be sending out letters with a generous time frame to remedy whatever your situation may be.

Rent is still due on the 1st, late on the 5th, but, as always, I will work with anyone having a hard time paying the rent if this virus has effected you. As long as the Government stays up and running and checks are mailed, you have no excuse for not paying the rent if this is your main source of income. Should the Office remain closed, you can put your May rent check in the office door, in the slot that says "US MAIL". If you normally pay in cash, get a money order (free at Amscot or available at Publix).

Being a Senior Park, all residents are in the high risk bracket; stay in the Park as much as possible; go for walks, sit by the Lake, ride your bike, take a daily golf cart ride, etc. Check on your neighbors; if you have extra supplies and you know of someone in need, please share. If you have been exposed and told to self-isolate, please do so.

I left the Laundromats open, as well as the Library. I felt that the Library has valuable resources to keep the residents occupied during this stress full time, and there is never 10 or more people there at a time.

Several residents have contacted me about other residents who continue to have "carport" parties. By now you know my motto, "You can't fix stupid". It's sad to know that these residents have no regards for other residents.

I have asked the Realtors to not show mobile homes during this time; if they choose to show them anyway, I will not be accepting tenant applications. This decision is based on the fact that I have no way of knowing if these prospective tenants have been taking any Covid-19 precautions; my concern is the health and welfare of the residents.

We are approaching hurricane season, please review the guidelines you need to follow in the case of a hurricane.

As you may have noticed, new stop signs have been installed-they are larger and the posts are taller. Unfortunately some residents still can't see them!

I am also receiving complaints that people that walk their dogs on the grass between the Park and Publix are not using doggie bags; if this continues, you may find that this area will be closed to dog walking by the owners and/or city. Again, a few bad apples may spoil this for everyone.

There will be no May meeting, I will schedule a Manager's Meeting for June 10th, 9:00 A.M. for coffee and cake, meeting at 9:30 a.m. Signs will be posted to confirm (or cancel) this meeting based on what the current "safe at home" order is.



Sea turtles may be eating ocean plastic

Plastic in the ocean is a growing environmental threat, and ecologists have recently recognized a new danger—to sea turtles. The Science News website reports that plastic in ocean water smells like food to the turtles, who then eat it or get tangled up in it and die.

Plastic debris in the ocean degrades, producing a chemical gas that smells like phytoplankton, an important source of nutrition to birds and fish. A study of loggerhead sea turtles in tanks found that the turtles generally avoid fresh plastics. Then scientists puffed air



into the tanks containing the scent of food and ocean-cooked plastic. That led to the turtles foraging more above water for food, and they were unable to distinguish between the smell of food or plastic. Thus, they were more likely to either eat the plastic or get entangled in it, both of which are harmful.

Another reminder to be careful of what you throw in the trash. You don't know where it might end up.

Embrace conservation

If you want to conserve natural resources and improve your quality of life, choose three of the following ways suggested by environmental activist David Suzuki:

- 1. Reduce home energy use by 10%.
- 2. Choose an energy-efficient home and appliances.
- 3. Don't use pesticides.
- 4. Eat meat-free meals one day a week.
- 5. Buy locally grown and produced food.
- 6. Choose a fuel-efficient vehicle.
- 7. Walk, bike, carpool, or take transit.
- 8. Choose a home close to work or school.
- 9. Support alternative transportation.



After a few months, he began to recall about 10 years of his past life, but that didn't nudge him back into his old habits. For the next year, his family had the opportunity to know him and love him as a model father and husband. And then one night, this second chance at love and life unexpectedly ended: The man died in his sleep.

His legacy? A message to love as well as you can, whenever you can, as much as you can.
