LETTER FROM LAWN MAINTENANCE FIRM TO EMBASSY RESIDENTS

CreativNature, Inc.

September 29, 2015

Dear Residents,

As you may know, CreativNature is contracted to maintain the turf in the common areas at Embassy Mobile Home Park. We have been doing this for a few months now and we would like share with you a few of our company policies that are in place to assure the safety of residents and their personal items, as well as our CreativNature Team and our equipment.

1. While the CreativNature Team is working at Embassy Mobile Home Park they are very focused on managing their equipment and task. **Please do not attempt to talk to or interfere with a crew member while they are operating equipment.** This is very dangerous and under no circumstances should you step into the way of moving equipment or attempt to distract a crew member while working.
2. **The sequence of service is weed eating, edging, mowing, and then blowing off the property.** Please allow us to finish our work in that order. **If, at the end of the day it is something quick, contact the Forman when the Team is at the trailer not operating equipment, or please contact Jessie at the office.** If we have left the property for the day, please address any concerns you have at the office on the form provided there.
3. **We are not able to do additional personalized services.** CreativNature is not able to personalize lawn maintenance to individual specification. We are mowing the park at 4 inches in height, which is adequate for all types of Florida grass. We are contracted to mow communal areas of the park and it's a very big property. In order to get the property done in a timely manner we are obligated to attend primarily to communal areas of turf.
4. **Personal items left in the yard on mow day create hazardous challenges for both the items and the mowers.** CreativNature has a company policy that requires our crew to not touch personal items left out in the yard. Further, to avoid damage to those items they are given a wide berth with both mowers and weed eaters. Items left in the yard like hoses that can't be seen create hazards for both the hose and the mower blades. Please remove items from the yard to avoid these damages. CreativNature cannot be responsible for damage caused by residents leaving items in the yard. If possible please place things like small lights and decorations in gardens behind barriers.
5. Post emergent spray edging will be done **quarterly** to manage turf around difficult to trim areas such as plumbing, air conditioners, and siding that could be damaged by using equipment near them

Our goal at CreativNature is to provide efficient turf management to the community areas at Embassy Mobile Home Park and to create a safe working environment for our Team and residents. We hope these policies will help to make the process simple and satisfying for everyone at Embassy Mobile Home Park.

Thank you so much for taking the time to review these policies. **If you have any questions or concerns, please contact your park manager Jessie, or fill out a feedback form located at the office. Any concerns submitted to the office will be addressed on the next service day before service begins.**

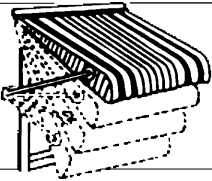

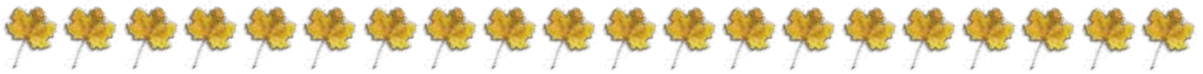

Have a nice flight (if you can)

Flying may be the fastest and safest way to travel, but we all have our own preferences and quirks when traveling by air. A survey of more than 1,100 family travelers by ExpertFlyer looked at passenger habits. Their findings included:



- **Airline choice.** United? American? Southwest? Forty-five percent of participants said that airline mile redemption was a factor in choosing which airline to fly on.
- **Storage space.** Space is at a premium on most airplanes. Seventy-five percent admitted to “stealing” overhead bin space beyond their authorized allotment.
- **Food.** In-flight meals aren’t the only option if you’re hungry. More than one-third of passengers said they bring their own food to eat during flight.
- **Complaints.** Flying can be stressful. The top complaint: A bad seat or a seat not near companions (35 percent), followed by delays (25 percent), and general discomfort (24 percent).
- **Worries.** Lost luggage is one thing, but 21 percent of survey participants said that terrorism is their biggest concern when traveling with their families. That was followed by getting lost or separated (19 percent) and crime (19 percent).

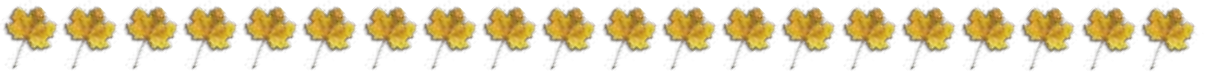
Who’s drinking all the coffee?

Lots of people depend on coffee to get them through the day. According to figures from Gallup, 64 percent of U.S. adults drink at least one cup a day. Some drink more:

- One cup 26 percent
- Two cups 19 percent
- Three cups 8 percent
- Four or more 11 percent
- None 36 percent



Coffee is somewhat more popular with the older generation, with 74 percent of people 55 or older drinking it daily, a habit shared by just 50 percent of the 18-34 crowd. Women drink a little more than men: Sixty-six percent of women report having one or more cups per day, while 62 percent of men say the same. And Caucasians drink more than African-Americans—67 percent to 59 percent.

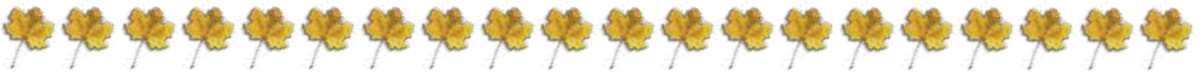

Moo! Cows may be smarter than you think

What's the smartest animal you can think of? Dolphins and chimpanzees may spring to mind quickly, but don't neglect one often-overlooked farm animal: the cow.

College students at the University of Sydney (as reported by the Huffington Post) conducted experiments with dairy cows and found that our bovine friends are capable of quickly mastering a maze to find food, and thus may possess better problem-solving skills than previously known.

The cows were tested in a T-shaped maze similar to those used with mice and rats. They learned to follow a sound through the maze to get to their food, with one of them reaching its goals within the first 20 seconds of the test.

The results suggest that cattle farmers could train cows to obey specific sound signals to come in for milking, producing greater efficiency on dairy farms.

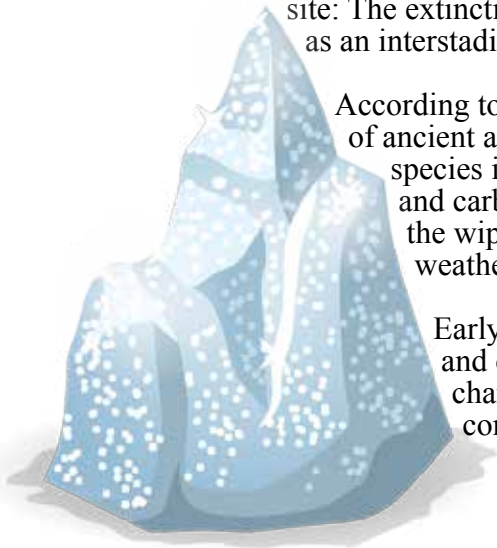


Global warming, not Ice Age, may have killed mammoths

Giant woolly mammoths roamed the Earth until about 11,000 years ago, when they abruptly went extinct. For years, scientists theorized that they were killed by the cold temperatures of the last Ice Age. Now some believe the explanation is just the opposite: The extinction event was caused by a sudden warming event known as an interstadial.

According to research published in the journal *Science*, DNA studies of ancient animals point to the sudden extinction of many large species in past ages. As more DNA from fossils became available, and carbon dating methods improved, scientists discovered that the wipeouts didn't correspond to the rise of glaciers and cold weather, but rather to periods of rapid global warming.

Early humans also contributed to the demise of the mammoths and other large beasts, but the evidence suggests that climate change was a major factor in their extinction—raising concerns about the future of our present environment.

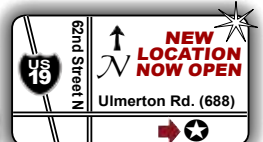

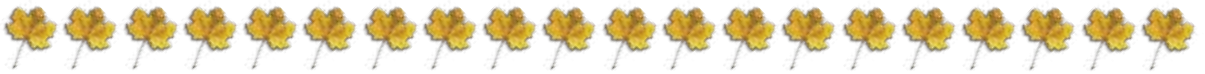

- Get a smoke-free room. Avoid exposure to leftover smoke and nicotine by requesting a smoke-free floor when you make your reservations, or at least a nonsmoking room.
- Resist the minibar. Decline a minibar key when you check in. You'll be free of temptation to indulge in unhealthy (and expensive) drinks and snacks.
- Ditch the bed cover. Bed covers can be hiding places for bugs and other pests. Store it in a dresser or a corner of your room before going to bed.
- Bring your own disinfectant. Wipe down the phone, TV remote, and other devices with an antibacterial spray or wipe before using them to get rid of any harmful bacteria and germs from previous guests.
- Use fresh cups. Don't drink from reusable glasses and cups. Stick with your own water bottle, or plastic disposable cups wrapped in plastic.



Don't sabotage your diet during the long afternoon

- Avoiding the gym. Schedule time for exercise; don't skip it just because you're busy or tired. Burning calories is important to staying in shape.
- The coffee shop. If you need a dose of caffeine, don't overload on extra sugar and cream, and resist the scones and muffins. Have a cup of coffee or tea at work, or ask a friend to pick up something salubrious for you so you don't face the temptation.
- Workplace celebrations. Birthdays, showers, good-bye parties and the like usually feature treats that can pack on the pounds. Share your good wishes, but don't go overboard on the goodies.
