

Some Reminders on Rules for Fairway Residents

RULE
#6 - Umbrella style laundry lines must be collapsed when not in use. Hanging laundry in driveway or carport is prohibited.

- #7 Overnight parking in the street is prohibited. You must not park on sidewalks or grassy area between sidewalk and street.
 - #8 Garbage can must be stored in your shed.
 - #13 You must register any overnight guests with the office.
 - #17 Only golfers are allowed on the golf course.
- #19 No food or drink (except for clear water bottles) are allowed at the pools. No private parties at the pool.
 - #22 Speed limit is 15 miles per hour.
- #25 Residents and guests must wear footwear and cover-ups/shirts when riding in golf carts, going to or from the pool, cycling, or walking in the village.
- #31 Tricycles, bicycles and golf carts ridden after dark must have a front light and back reflector. Motorcycles may only be used between 8:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m.



We're all moving to the big city

The days of living far out in the country appear to be dwindling, according to a report from the Population Division of the U.N. Department of Economic and Social Affairs. Approximately 4.2 billion people live in urban areas worldwide, and 2.5 billion more are expected to join them in the next 30 years—68 percent of the world's population.

The U.N. predicts that by 2030, the world will have 43 "megacities," with populations of more than 10 million people. The world's largest city will be New Delhi, outpacing Tokyo with a population of 43.3 million inhabitants by 2035.

In the meantime, the rural population is expected to peak and then decline to 3.1 billion by 2050.



Technology—good or evil?

o you love all the new technology or hate it? Chances are it's a little bit of both. In a survey by Vrge Strategies, 81 percent of respondents said that smartphones, the internet, and other technologies have made their lives better—but at the same time, 51 percent said they believe these tools have had a negative impact on society.

The respondents were concerned about security. Forty-one percent said the internet and other new technologies should have more regulation than they do now, and 72 percent don't think lawmakers are keeping up, given the rapid pace of change in the tech industry.

Another concern: income inequality. Thirty-eight percent of participants in the survey said they believe technology increases the gap between the rich and the poor—although 22 percent said they think new tech reduces the gap.

Teens and social media use

Instagram is fading in popularity among teenagers, according to a Pew Research Center study, and YouTube appears to be taking its place.

The survey, reported on the Pittsburgh Post-Gazette website, found that 85 percent of teenagers in the United States are users of YouTube, but only 72 percent are using Instagram (owned by social media giant Facebook), and 69 percent use Snapchat.

Use of Facebook's main site is down to 51 percent among teens, dropping from 71 percent in 2014-15.



The Pew study also found that 95 percent of teenagers either own a smartphone or have access to one, a rise from 73 percent in the previous survey, and 45 percent report using the internet "almost constantly," almost double the percentage from the earlier survey.
